

Fabula Garnacha

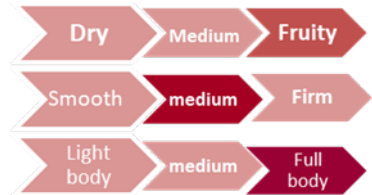
Full-bodied red with ripe black and red fruits and a smoky, slightly spicy edge. Garnacha is known for its high alcohol.

In this wine, it's really well-balanced by ripe cherry, plums and blackberry flavours, moderate tannins, and a fantastic earthy, smoky, peppery finish.

Food match: Enjoy with spicy or peppery vegetable or meat dishes.

What's special about this wine?

This wine range is from a less well-known region, where the price:quality ratio is exceptional.

- Origin: Carinena, Spain is about half-way between Rioja and Barcelona. The area enjoys sunny days (giving ripe fruit) and cool nights (maintaining its freshness).
- Producer: Bodegas Paniza, a co-op, which offers exceptional price:quality in this range.
- Fabula means 'fable' and each label carries an image relating to a fable. "And after years forgotten, she regained her rightful throne". Garnacha is usually blended with other varieties; in this case it stands alone, quite regal.
