- Origin: Carinena, Spain is about half-way between Rioja and Barcelona. The area enjoys sunny days (giving ripe fruit) and cool nights (maintaining its freshness).
- 90% Tempranillo, with the balance equally split between Cabernet Sauvignon and Garnacha. Aged in American oak for 6 months before release. 1953 relates to the year the winery was established.
