

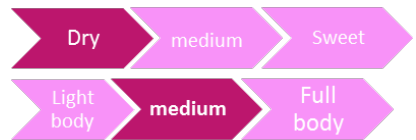

Lagoalva Azulejo Rosé (Tejo IGP)

Unlike the famous Mateus Rosé, this pretty little one is dry, with flavours of red berries.

Food match: Good with cold roast meats and salads.

- Lagoalva translates at the white lagoon.
- The Quinta (or farm) is 1 hour north of Lisbon. It's one of the biggest farms in Portugal, at 7,000ha. The family has a large agricultural business, growing cereal crops, as well as a stud farm. In the early 1990s, they planted vines, and now 50ha are devoted to vineyards. They were the first to plant Syrah.
- This wine is made from Syrah & Touriga Nacional. Grapes are picked at night time to retain freshness. The grapes are given 7 hours skin contact, before being pressed and fermented at low temperature (10-12°C) to retain fresh fruit flavours.
