

## Lagoalva Azulejo White (Tejo IGP)

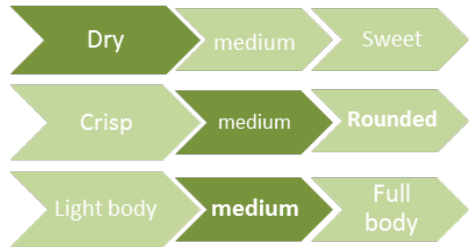
If you like Sauvignon Blanc, try this!

It's a delicate pale colour, with crisp zesty flavours of lemon and pink grapefruit. Named 'Azulejo' after Portugal's famously pretty ceramic tiles.

**Food match:** Super with anything lemony - fish, chicken, salads.

### Like to know more?:

- Lagoalva translates at the white lagoon.
- The Quinta (or farm) is 1 hour north of Lisbon. It's one of the biggest farms in Portugal, at 7,000ha. The family has a large agricultural business, growing cereal crops, as well as a stud farm. In the early 1990s, they planted vines, and now 50ha are devoted to vineyards. They were the first to plant Syrah.
- This wine is a blend of Alvarinho & Verdelho grapes. (Alvarinho is the same as Spain's Albariño).
- Grapes are picked at night-time, when it's cooler, to retain freshness.
