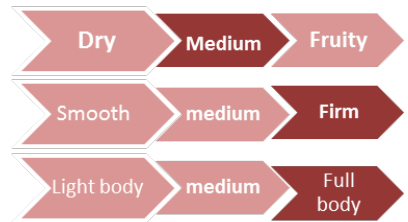
St Emilion Grand Cru

Exquisite, complex fragrance of prunes, toasty oak and a hint of chocolate, and violets. Rich mouthfilling presence; quite full-bodied and long. Drinking really well now.

Food match: Superb with rich red meats, such as roast rib of beef.

What's special about this wine?

- Many St. Emilion Grand Crus do not live up to the expectation of a 'Grand Cru'; this one does!



Like to know more?

- Region: St. Emilion, in Bordeaux's right bank.
- This wine is the second wine of Ch Laroque St. Emilion Grand Cru Classé, the largest estate in St. Emilion, at 61ha.
- It is situated at the highest point of St. Emilion.
- Made from 30 year old vines (96% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc).
- Partially barrique-aged for added complexity.
