**Food match:** Enjoy with rich or slightly spicy dishes, eg. Chili, beef fajitas.

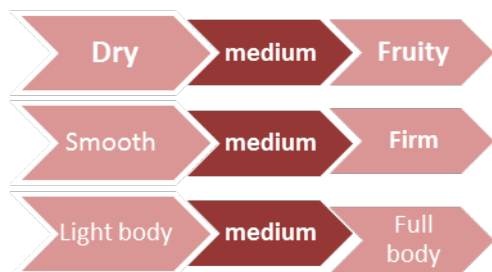
