

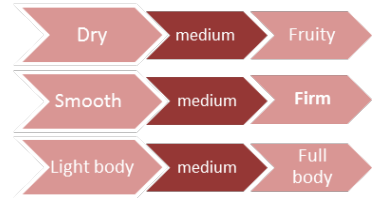
Sancho Garces Rioja Crianza
