- St. Joseph was given its name by Jesuit priests in the 17th century.
- Varietals: 100% Syrah (Shiraz).
- Vines are planted on steep hillsides, mostly granite, which enables ripening and provides important drainage for the roots.
- The grapes are cold-soaked before fermentation. The wine is aged in oak after fermentation.
- This wine drinks well now, and will continue to improve for 5-8 years from vintage.
