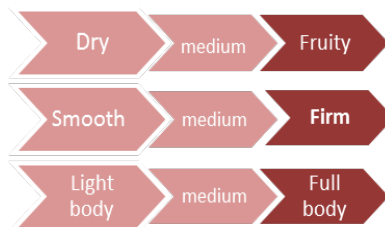


dA Malbec

- Origin: Domaine Astruc, near Limoux. in Languedoc Roussillon
- Varieties: 90% Malbec, 10% Cabernet Franc.
- 30% of the blend is aged in new oak barrel for 4 months.
- Producer: Paul Mas is one of the most highly regarded producers in the Languedoc.
