

- 1. Since we produce full shell custom in-ear monitors a full impression is required for each ear, which includes the full helix, crus of the helix, tragus and antitragus. Cord exits above tragus so leave a little bit of extra material in this area. Ear impression also must be taken past the SECOND BEND of the ear canal. (Please check for inflammation or excess ear wax)
- 2. We require silicone ear impression material thats medium to high viscosity.

(We do not accept powder and liquid material nor Westone X-ACT red silicone material)

3. To achieve a better seal in the final product we require an OPEN MOUTH impression using a 1"-2" bite block, which will help reduce jaw movement during the curing process.
