Bluetooth Headset USER MANUAL



In Order to have a proper and safe use of the headset, please read this user manual in detail and save it.

Be aware of the following guidelines when using your headset:

1. You should adjust the volume carefully when using the headset to prevent hearing damage. If it seems too high or you experience ringing in your ears, please reduce the volume.
2. Please stop using the headset in potentially hazardous situations to ensure your safety. Do not use while driving.
3. Put this product and its accessories somewhere out of the reach of children, to avoid danger caused by inappropriate use.
4. You should keep water from entering the headset, which may cause damage to the headset.
5. Stop using if you feel obvious discomfort, irritation or have other adverse reactions.
6. Do not store or use headset at temperatures below -15C (5F) or above 55C (131F) which may shorten the life of the headset or battery.

To reconnect the paired headset with your phone:

1. Keep the distance of the headset and phone within 3ft.
2. Switch on the Bluetooth mode of your phone or other device being connected.
3. Hold down the MF button until the LED flashes Blue, the headset will enter into reconnection mode when the blue light blinks and automatically reconnect with the phone.

Answer incoming call:

- Press the MF button once to answer an incoming call, or use your cell phone to answer it.

Hang up a call:

- Press the MF button once or use your cell phone to hang up your call.

Music Play/Pause:

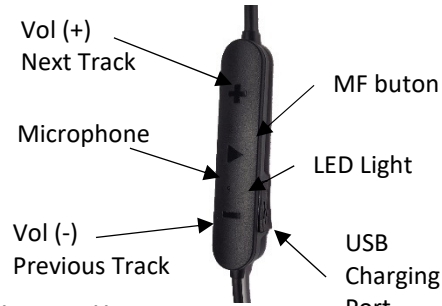
- Press MF button once to play/pause music.

Volume adjustment/Music selection:

- Press and release Vol(+) or Vol(-) to adjust volume; press and hold the Vol(+) and Vol(-) to select previous track or next track.

Overview of ZS-BT1 headset controls:



Charger and battery

1. Before Charging, make sure the headset has been switched off.
2. Plug USB cable into the charging port of the headset; plug the other side of the USB cable into a USB charger or other charging device. The Red light will illuminate to indicate the device is charging.
3. Charging time of headset takes approximately two hours. The Red LED will turn Blue when fully charged and then turn off.

Warning: You must use the original cable to charge the Bluetooth headset, otherwise it may damage the headset. Voltage of charger must be 5V, with an electric current of at least 100mA. This headset uses a non-detachable built-in rechargeable battery, in order to prevent damage to the headset, please do not remove the battery.

Power on:

- Press and hold the MF button until blue LED light blinks.

Pairing Mode:

- Press and hold the MF button until blue and red LED lights blink alternatively.

Switch off:

- Press and hold the MF button until red LED light blinks and goes out.

Pair your headset with your cell phone:

1. Keep the distance between the headset and cell phone (or other devices being connected) within 3 Feet.
2. Press and hold the MF button until the blue and red LED lights blink alternatively.
3. Initiate Bluetooth function of cell phone (or other device being connected). "ZS-BT1" will be shown as an available device on your phone.
4. Select "ZS-BT1." The headset will automatically connect with the cell phone., The blue LED light begins to blink. **Attention:** Generally, there is 120 seconds maximum to pair the headset with your cell phone, or the pairing mode will stop, indicated by the LED lights stop blinking. Please repeat steps 1 to 4 to complete the pairing process.

To disconnect the headset with your cell phone:

- Turn off the Bluetooth function on your cell phone, or
- press and hold the MF button on the headset until the red LED light flashes once, or
- take the headset more than 30ft from the phone.

FAQ

1. Headset cannot pair with phone?
Ans: Open your phone's Bluetooth menu and delete/forget the "ZS-BT1" paired device. Then repeat the steps for pairing your headset with your phone.
2. Headset will not turn on?
Ans: Make sure your headset is fully charged.
3. Can I change the battery for the headset?
Ans: No. this headset use a built-in non-detachable Li-Polymer battery, it cannot be removed.
4. Can I use headset while driving?
Ans: For safety reason, we strongly recommend not to use headset while driving.
5. Headset has disconnected with your cell phone within 10 meters?
Ans: Please check if there is metal or other material within a relatively close range which may interfere with the Bluetooth connection. Bluetooth is a radio technology which is sensitive to objects between the headset and the connected device.

6. I cannot hear a sound from the computer or cell phone?
Ans: Please check whether the output channel of your computer is Bluetooth, that the Audio Device and Bluetooth function of your computer support A2DP profile. And please check that the volume on your headset/computer/cell phone is turned up.
7. I cannot use the headset to control an APP on my cell phone.
Ans: The Software settings of the APP may not be compatible with the functions of the headset.
