

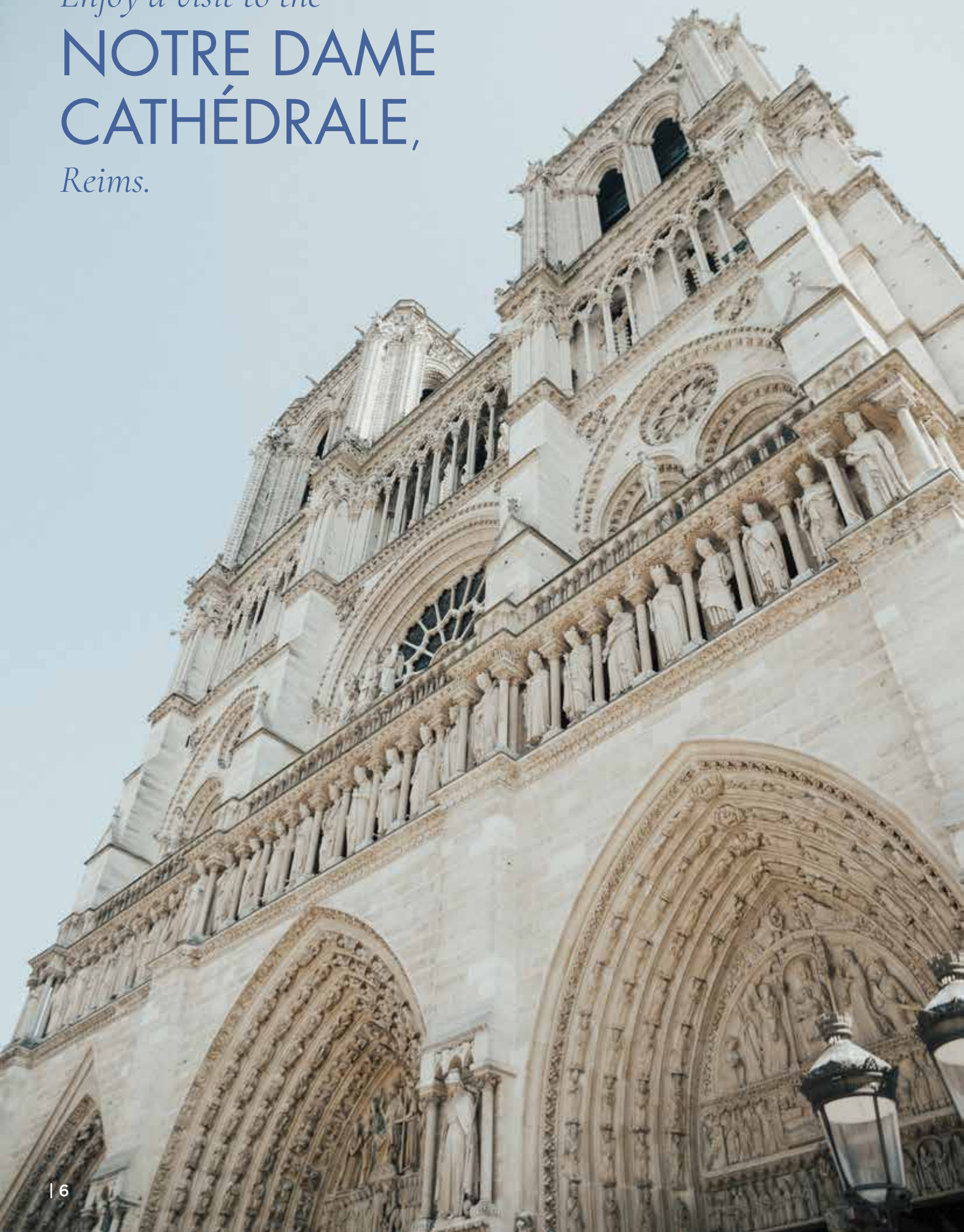
Guests will then be transported to the Champagne region for an incredible week of private tastings, lunches with the chef de cave (winemaker) and dinners with members of famous champagne families.
