This is a square foot material allowance or the total amount you wish to spend on a project. You can also provide the total surface area if given.

Choose an Installer.

Providing us with your installer's name and contact info allows us to discuss the nuances of your project, need dates for material, and the final quantities needed to place your order and complete the job. We are happy to provide you with recommendations if needed.

Bring Samples.

When you come in for your appointment, bring along any design selections or materials you've already chosen–like countertops, cabinets, paint, fabric, etc. If you already have a countertop, sharing its name is helpful. If you haven't selected any yet, we can help you pull some together from our samples, as we keep many swatches of other material on hand to help guide you.

Layouts & Measuring

Confirm measurements with a contractor or installer before making your purchase. They will calculate overage for waste or a pattern repeat based on the layout of your choice. Bring your floor plans or a roughly sketched layout if you have them. Even a quick room layout sketch on the back of this paper is helpful.

TILE PROJECT CONSIDERATIONS

*Cut tile creates a durable baseboard. Use a bullnose or simply cut the tile up to 8" and top it with a trim.

**In lieu of grout, grass, gravel, or sand can also be used with 2cm pavers.

***Sealers are recommended for natural stones and ceramic with high water absorption.

Sealers may also be used as a grout release if applied before grouting, to assist with clean-up.
