USB CD PLAYER Installation Instructions

- STEP 1 Turn your radio on
- STEP 2 Connect the USB CD Player chord to the USB port

THIS CD PLAYER HAS TO PAIR WITH YOUR VEHICLE. IT WILL NOT WORK UNTIL YOU LOCATE THE "SOURCE" or "USB ICON" ON YOUR RADIO SCREEN TO CONNECT IT.

STEP 3 Depending on the make of your vehicle,

Press Media, or Source, or Aux, or Audio, or Media then Source
on your dashboard screen. Next, look for "SOURCE" or USB 1 or USB 2

STEP 4 Wait 20-30 seconds for the USB symbol to appear, then select the USB option that will connect the CD player to your vehicle.

Select USB 1 or USB 2 (depending on which port you plugged into)

Having trouble connecting your USB CD Player?

Call your local car dealership and ask for the Service Department.

Ask them to help you connect an external device through the USB port.

- STEP 5 **Insert a disc in CD Player** (The unit may not be found by your vehicle's radio until a CD has been inserted into the CD player. This can take 20-30 seconds)
- STEP 6 **INDEXING Process** *Wait 30 seconds* for the USB processing hub to completely acquire the CD information. Even if the CD has begun playing, you *must wait 30 seconds for the indexing to be completed* to avoid potential issues.
- STEP 7 Congratulations! Your CD Player will now operate through the factory radio display on the dashboard and with the controls on your steering wheel.

PLEASE NOTE: Some USB Hubs are sensitive to this procedure.

If you have interrupted the process, simply remove the disc and insert a different disc.

Repeat the instructions above. This will reset the vehicle's USB Hub memory.
