A Modern Twist

Here's a modern, minimalist twist on the traditional "orange peel" or "pumpkin seed" quilt block.
The design is clean and fresh. Make it in solids, tone-on-tones, traditional reproductions or use bright, busy prints for the leaves and a spare neutral for the backgrounds. Quilt it by hand or machine, or use a thicker thread and a large utility stitch to add visual texture. Perfect art for a special wall!

Supplies needed

- · leaves eight 3" x 6" scraps
- center square one 10" x 10" scrap
- · borders 1/2 yard
- backing 3/4 yard
- binding 1/4 yard

Cut — read all directions before beginning leaves — cut eight strips 2-1/2" \times 6", one from each fabric center square — cut one square 8-1/2" \times 8-1/2" borders — cut one rectangle 3-1/2" \times 8-1/2", piece A= cut one rectangle 11-1/2" \times 9", piece B cut one rectangle 9-1/2" \times 17", piece C cut one rectangle 4" \times 20-1/2, piece D \times


Directions


All seams are 1/4-inch


- Sew two leaf strips together. Make four one for each leaf.
- 2. Use leaf template to cut out four leaves. Note: Template does not include seam allowance.
- 3. Starting with piece A, then B, then C and then D, sew borders on to the edges of center square. Press seams towards borders.
- 4. See diagram, right. Place the center junction of the leaves in the center of the center square. The leaf seams are at 90° angles to each other. The leaves are rotated so each leaf seam is 1-3/8" from the corners of the center block. Use your favorite method to applique the leaves in place.
- 5. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

More ideas:

- After quilting, this piece would also make a very nice 20-inch pillow!
 - together as shown for a baby quilt Make four panels, rotate and sew or larger wall art.
- sides of the center square to make 4-1/2", 4" finished) on to all four Sew equal narrow borders (cut a small 12-inch pillow.
- Applique the center square and then the leaves on to a canvas tote bag.
- or color; rotate as shown and omit square and border units with each side border a different fabric and/ Make four or six of the center the applique!
