# Part A – Assembly


#### Step 1 – Unpack Materials

Please check that you have everything listed below. If you are missing a part, please contact us.

#### **Chair Parts:**

1 pre-assembled chair back 1 pre-assembled chair seat

2 chair legs 2 chair arms 1 front slat



#### Hardware:

- 4 Bolts (5/16" x 21/2")
- 4 Locking Nuts (5/16")
- 2 Small Washers
- 12 Medium Washers
- 2 Large Washers
- 2 Extra Large "sticky" washers
- 8 Short Screws (2")
- 2 Long Screws (6" X 1/4")
- 1 Hex Wrench (1 per order)
- 1 Robertson (square) Screwdriver (1 per order)



#### **Additional Tools Required:**

1/2" (or 11mm) Socket Wrench 7/16" (or 13mm) Socket Wrench or Needle Nose Vice Grip Pliers


#### Step 2 - Attach Legs to Seat Assembly

Orient the chair leg marked with an "B" next to the side of the chair seat marked with "B"

 Ensure that the curve on the top edge of the leg faces up and toward the front of the seat



- Put a medium washer over a bolt. Screw the bolt through the leg hole from the outside using the Hex Wrench. Note – do not use a hammer to tap the bolt through the hole. This could damage the bolt
- Remove the backing from the extra large "sticky washer".
   Place it over the bolt and stick it to the side of the leg as shown below




• Screw the bolt through the hole on the side of the seat

- Important Wipe the bolt clean of any material that might have accumulated on the thread.
- Adding a drop of lubricant helps protect the bolt.
- Add a medium washer to the bolt. Then add a lock nut. Tighten the bolt using the hex wrench, holding the lock nut with the socket wrench or pliers.
- Repeat this process for the other side
- Open up legs, as in the picture below



#### Step 3 – Attach Front Slat


- Partially install 1 short screw on the front slat, so the screw just protrudes the back of the slat
- Position the protruding screw into the pre-drilled hole on the chair leg. Tighten the screw.



- Repeat this process with one screw on the other leg
- Install the remaining 6 screws

#### Step 4 – Attach Chair Arms to Legs

- Put a medium washer over a bolt
- Screw the bolt through the top of the leg, from the inside
- Add 1 large washer to the bolt



- Attach the chair arm, by screwing the bolt through the hole in the block under the arm
- Clean the threads on the bolt and add a drop of lubricant
- Add a small washer. Then add a lock nut to the bolt.
   Tighten the nut with the hex wrench and socket wrench or pliers



• Repeat the process with the second arm




#### Step 5 – Attach Chair Back to Arms

- Open the swivel blocks outwards
- Position the chair back on top of the seat legs. Lock the bottom of the back into place using the swivel blocks



- Place 1 small washer over the long screw
- Install the long screw into the back of the arm. As the screw begins to protrude from the arm, add two medium washers

Align the screw with the pre-drilled hole in the chair back.
 Continue to tighten the screw until snug



• Repeat the process with the other arm

#### Step 6 – Sit Back and Enjoy!

Note – the Swivel Blocks can be permanently attached by adding a 2 inch screw (not provided) to each swivel block. It is recommended that you pre-drill a hole through the swivel block before adding the screw to prevent the block from splitting.


# Part B - Folding Your Chair

#### Notes:

- 1. You may have to loosen the hardware slightly to fold your chair.
- 2. We recommend folding your chair on a soft surface (such as grass or a blanket) to protect your furniture

### Step 1 – Unlock Swivel Blocks

Move the 2 swivel blocks so they face out



## Step 2 – Release the Chair Back

- Stand behind the chair
- Lift up on the back of the arms
- As you lift the chair back and legs will fold forward



• Keep lifting until the chair folds flat on the ground



• Pivot the swivel blocks to align with the legs

# Part C - Unfolding Your Chair

#### Notes:

- The instructions are simply the reverse of the Folding Instructions described in Part B
- 2. You may have to tighten the hardware after unfolding your chair.
- 3. We recommend unfolding your chair on a soft surface (such as grass or a blanket) to protect your furniture

#### Step 1 – Open the Swivel Blocks

Move the 2 swivel blocks so they face out



## Step 2 – Unfold the Chair legs

- Stand in front of the chair
- Lift the front of the chair up using the chair arms
- Continue lifting until the chair legs are fully upright





## Step 3 – Unfold the Chair Back

- Stand behind the chair
- Lift the arms upwards until the chair back can be moved into position on top of the chair legs





• Pivot the swivel blocks to lock the seat back in place
