Welcome to the Blanket of Many Stitches KAL. Over the course of 10 biweekly installments you will make a striped stitch sampler blanket. Work through 4 colors of Cascade Yarns 220 Superwash®, switching colors as you change stitch patterns. Each stripe is approximately 2" and each stitch pattern is a repeat of 12 stitches. Add more stitches or repeat your favorite stitch patterns to make your blanket unique—just be sure to purchase more yarn if you intend on making it larger.

D: 4 skeins, color 290 (Chrysanthemum)

#### **Needles:**

US 7 (4.5 mm) 30+" circular knitting needle US 8 (5.0 mm) 30+" circular knitting needle F (3.75 mm) crochet hook

#### **Notions:**

Stitch markers, tapestry needle

#### Gauge:

22 sts x 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch using smaller needle

WYIB = With yarn held in back

#### Instructions:

Using A: With US 7 needle, cast on using a knitted cast-on or cable cast-on 200 stitches. If you want a wider blanket, cast on in increments of 12.

#### Garter Stitch Border (worked with color A):

Row 1: K10, PM, knit to last 10 stitches, SM, knit to end

Row 2: K10, SM, knit to last 10 stitches, SM, knit to end

Repeat Row 2 for 2"

Note: Each time you change color, check to see if the Preparation Rows are required. The need will be identified for each stripe. I recommend placing a marker every 24 stitches between the border markers.

Note: Work all pattern sections with US 7 needle unless otherwise specified.

#### #1 Diagonals (worked with color B)

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl – maintain the 10-stitch knit border on each end of the row

Row 1: K10, SM, \*K2, P2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 2: K10, SM, P1, \*K2, P2; Repeat from \* to 3 stitches before marker,

K2, P1, SM, K10

Row 3: K10, SM, \*P2, K2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 4: K10, SM, K1, \*P2, K2; Repeat from \* to 3 stitches before marker,

P2, K1, SM, K10

Repeat Rows 1 – 4 two more times.

#### #2 Dimples (worked with color C and US 8 needles)

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl – maintain the 10-stitch knit border on each end of the row

Row 1: (RS) K10, SM, \*K1, WYIB SL 1; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 2: (WS) K10, SM, \*WYIF SL 1 PW, P1; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 3: K10, SM, Knit to marker, SM, K10

Row 4: K10, SM, Purl to marker, SM, K10

Row 5: K10, SM, \*WYIB SL 1, K1; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 6: K10, SM, \*P1, WYIF SL 1 PW; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 7: K10, SM, Knit to marker, SM, K10

Row 8: K10, SM, Purl to marker, SM, K10

Repeat Rows 1-8 one more time



#### #3 Checkerboard (worked with color D)

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl – maintain the 10-stitch knit border on each end of the row

Row 1 (RS): K10, SM, \*K2, P2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 2 (WS): K10, SM, \*K2, P2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 3: K10, SM, \*P2, K2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Row 4: K10, SM, \*P2, K2; Repeat from \* to marker, SM, K10

Repeat Rows 1-4 two more times

Row 4: \*SL 1 WYIF, P3; repeat from \* to marker

Row 5: \*K3, SL 1 WYIB; repeat from \* to marker

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: \*K1, SL 1 WYIB, K2; repeat from \* to marker

Row 8: \*P2, SL 1 WYIF, P1; repeat from \* to marker

Row 9: \*K1, SL 1 WYIB, K2; repeat from \* to marker

Repeat Rows 2 – 6

Row 2: (WS) Purl to marker

Row 3: \*P4, K2; Repeat from \* to marker

Row 4: (WS) Purl to marker

Row 5: \* P1, K2; Repeat from \* to marker

Row 6: (WS) Purl to marker

Row 7: P1, \*K2, P4; Repeat from \* to 5 stitches before marker, K2, P3

Row 8: (WS) Purl to marker

Repeat Rows 1-4



Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl – maintain the 10-stitch knit border on each end of the row

Row 1 (RS): \*P1, SL1 WYIF\*; Repeat from \* to marker

Row 3: (RS) \* YO, K2, PYOK2, K2; Repeat from \* to marker

Row 4: (WS) Purl to marker

Repeat Rows 1-4 at least two more times

Row 3: \*SKP, YO; Repeat from \* to marker

Row 4: Purl to marker

Repeat Rows 1-4 at least two more times



#### #9 Andalusian Stitch Pattern (worked with color B and US 7 needles)

Row 1 (RS): Knit

Row 2 (WS): Purl

Row 3: \*K1, P1\*

Row 4: Purl

Repeat Rows 1 thru 4 two more times

Row 2 (Wrong Side): K3, \*P4, K4: repeat from \* to 5 stitches before the marker, P4, K1

Row 3: P2, \*K4, P4; Repeat from \* to 6 stitches before the marker, K4, P2



Row 4: Purl

Repeat Rows 1-4 two more times



Row 1 (RS): \* P2, K2, P2, K1, P2, K2, P1; repeat from \* to marker

Row 2 (WS): \* K1, P2, K2, P1, K2, P2, K2; repeat from \* to marker

Row 3: \* P1, K2, P2, K3, P2, K2; repeat from \* to marker

Row 4: \* P2, K2, P3, K2, P2, K1; repeat from \* to marker

Row 5: \* K2, P2, K2, P1, K2, P2, K1; repeat from \* to marker

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl - maintaining the 10-stitch knit border on each end of the row




#### #30 Checked Rose Fabric (worked with colors C and D and US 6 needles)

Preparation Row 1: (D) Knit Preparation Row 2: (D) Purl

Preparation Row 1 (RS): (D) Knit



Row 2 (RS): (C), K1 in row below, K1

Row 3 (WS): (D) K1 in row below, K1. Do not turn work at the end of the row

Row 4 (WS): Keeping wrong side of work facing you, slide stitches to right end of needle,

with C, K1, K1 in row below. Turn work at end of row

Row 5 (RS): (C) K1, K1 in row below. Do not turn work at the end of the row

Row 6 (RS): Keeping right side of work facing you, slide stitches to the right end of the nee-

dle. With D, K1 in row below, K1

Do rows 1-6 a total of 3 times.

With D, P 1 row

#### **Alternative Stitch Pattern for #30**

#### Salt and Pepper Tweed (worked with colors C and D and US 6 needles)

Row 1 (Color C): K1, sl 1 wyib

Row 2 (Color C): K1, sl 1 wyif

Row 3 (Color D): K1, sl 1 wyib

Row 4 (Color D): K1, sl 1 wyif



Repeat Rows 1-4 a total of 4 times.

#### Border (worked with color A and US 7 needles)

Row 1: K10, PM, knit to last 10 stitches, SM, knit to end

Row 2: K10, SM, knit to last 10 stitches, SM, knit to end

Repeat Row 2 for 2"

Bind off. Weave in loose ends. Block if desired. Single crochet border around edge of blanket.
