

# KNIT--MATIC

## Handspun Art Yarn Cowl

Pattern by Haley Waxberg

### Size

33" long x 6" wide (lying flat)

### Materials

- 1 skein *Studioloo Handspun Art Yarn* (yardages vary, ours was 140m)
- 1 skein *Cascade Spuntaneous* (200g/100m)
- 7mm/US10.75 needles
- 9mm/US13 needles

### Gauge

*Handspun*: 11 sts = 4"/10cm with 7mm/US10.75 in garter stitch

*Cascade Spuntaneous*: 13 sts = 4"/10cm with 9mm/US13 in K2P2 rib (unstretched)

### Abbreviations

- K knit  
kfb knit into the front and then the back of the stitch:

P purl  
R row or round  
St/s stitch(es)

### Notes

This cowl is a great way to make the most of Handspun Art Yarn! Choose a complimentary colour of commercial yarn to create textural contrast.

### Directions

With 7mm/US10.75 needles and *Studioloo Handspun Art Yarn* cast on 16 sts. Knit until you run out of yarn (finish at the end of a row, not in the centre of a row). Change to *Cascade Spuntaneous*.

**Next row:** K1, kfb, k3, kfb, k3, kfb, k3, kfb, k to end. (20 sts).

Change to 9mm/US13 needles.

**Next row:** \*K2, P2; repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat this row until work is desired length.

Bind off loosely. Seam ends together using mattress stitch (<https://youtu.be/wQnAfTmI0iA>). Weave in ends ([https://youtu.be/cTABJqt\\_dXw](https://youtu.be/cTABJqt_dXw)).
