

KNIT--MATIC

Super Simple Striped Baby Blanket

Pattern by Haley Waxberg

Size

Approx 34" x 34" (86 x 86cm)

Materials

6 skeins Berroco Vintage
Chunky (100g/120m
(130yds); 1 skein each:

- 6181 Black Cherry
- 6176 Pumpkin
- 6175 Fennel
- 6197 Neptune
- 61182 Indigo
- 6107 Cracked Pepper

6mm/US10-29" circular
needles

Gauge

14 sts = 4"/10cm in garter
stitch

Techniques

Weaving in ends with
duplicate stitch:

Directions

Loosely cast on 120 stitches.

Knit every row until you have knit the entire skein, ending after finishing an even numbered row (approximately 32 to 36 rows) – you'll need approximately 5.35m/18 feet of yarn to finish the last two rows).

Switch to the second colour at the beginning of the next row, leaving a 5" to 6" tail for each colour.

Knit every row until you have knit the entire skein, ending after finishing an even numbered row.

Repeat with each colour, making sure to always switch colours after finishing an even numbered row. After knitting the last colour, loosely bind off.

Finishing

Weave in the ends (see very helpful tutorial in *Techniques*: "Garter: Weaving in ends with duplicate stitch").
