

# KNIT--MATIC

## Rialto Baby Hat

Pattern by Haley Waxberg

### Size

Preemie (newborn, baby, toddler)

Head circumference: 11(12-13, 14-15, 16-17)" or 27.5(30-32.5, 35-37.5, 40-42.5)cm

### Materials

- Debbie Bliss Rialto DK Print; 50g/105m, 1 ball
- Debbie Bliss Cashmerino DK; 50g/110m (or Debbie Bliss Rialto DK), 1 ball
- 4mm-16" circular needles
- 3.5mm-16" circular needles
- 4mm double pointed needles
- 1 stitch marker
- darning needle (preferably pointy & small)

### Gauge

22 sts & 30 rounds = 4"/10cm with 4mm circular needles

### Abbreviations

K	Knit
K2tog	Knit 2 sts tog at the same time
P	Purl
R	Row or round
St/s	Stitch/es
Tog	Together

### Notes

This hat is a fast & easy little gift that will impress for sure! It features a modified roll-brim edge with 2x2 ribbing, and the crown has a tied i-cord. It is made with 2 coordinating shades of yarn, one solid colour and one self striping.



### Directions

With solid colour & 3.5mm needles cast on 64(72, 80, 88) sts. Join in the round, careful not to twist sts, place marker at join. Knit for 6 rounds.

\*K2, P2; rep from \* to end of round. Repeat for another 5 rounds.

Next Round: Knit, increasing 0(0, 1, 2) sts evenly. 64(72, 81, 90)sts.

Change to striped yarn and 4mm needles, knit until hat measures 4(4.75, 5.25, 5.75)" or 10(12, 13.25, 14.5)cm from rolled edge (natural roll, not pulled flat).

Next Round: Knit, decreasing 1(0, 0, 0) st before end of round. 63(72, 81, 90)sts. Change to solid colour.

### Crown Decreases

R1: \*K7, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round. K 1 round.

R3: \*K6, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round. K 1 round.

R5: \*K5, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round. K 1 round.

R7: \*K4, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round. K 1 round.

R9: \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round. K 1 round.

R11: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round.

R12: \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end of round.

R13: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end of round.

R14: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end of round or until 4 sts rem.

Make i-cord: working on 2 double pointed needles, distribute all sts to 1 needle. Knit sts, but do not turn work at end of row. \*Slide sts to opposite end of needle, pull yarn tight and knit. Repeat from \* for 4"/10cm. K2tog, K2tog, slips 1st st over 2nd, pull end through last st & tighten. With darning needle pull end down through i-cord. Tie cord into knot, weave in ends.
