

Skill Level: beginner

Pattern by Haley

Boboli Cowl (worsted)

size

After blocking & lying flat: 15.5"/40cm wide, 19.5"/50cm long.

gauge

16 stitches and 23 rows = 4"/10cm after blocking in stocking stitch on 4.5mm.

abbreviations

K Knit
K2tog Knit 2 stitches together
M1 [Make 1 increase](#): With left needle tip, lift strand between needles from front to back. Knit lifted loop through the back.
P Purl
St/s Stitch/es

materials

4mm-24" circular needles
4.5mm-24" circular needles
2 skeins *Berroco Boboli*, 100g/190m, colour 5312 Bon Bon
Stitch Marker
Eucalan
1/2 cup white vinegar



directions

With smaller needles, cast on 108 sts. Join in the round, place marker.

R1 to 5: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of round.

R6: *k6, m1; rep from * to end of round. (126 sts) Change to larger needles.

Knit in the round until piece measures approx 17" inches from cast on.

Next Round: *k5, k2tog; rep from * to end of round. (108 sts.)
Change to smaller needles.

Repeat R 1 to 5. Cast off loosely in ribbing. Weave in ends.

Hand wash in *Eucalan* and 1/2 cup white vinegar, lay flat to dry (add the vinegar before you immerse the cowl to the water).

Notes:

This pattern is a simple, elegant cowl that can be worn up or down. You can make a finer version with one strand of yarn, or a bulkier version holding 2 strands together.

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
