

Frolic Shawl

size

One Size: 44" wide & 22" long

gauge

15 sts & 32 rows = 4"/10cm

materials

MC: 1 ball Berroco Remix (100g/200m)
CC: 1 skein Noro Taiyo (100g/200m)
5mm/US8-32" circular needles (or longer)
2 Stitch markers
Measuring tape (60" or longer)

abbreviations

Bef before
CC Contrast colour
K Knit
LLI Lifted Increase Left Slant
MC Main Colour
PM Place Marker on needle
Pwise purl-wise
R Row
RLI Lifted Increase Right Slant
SI Slip
SL M Slip marker to other needle
St/s Stitch/es

Notes:

This is a simple & fast little shawl you can whip up in no time. The yarn does all the work, but you get all the glory!

Do not knit tightly, you can be loose and relaxed with this pattern. To change colours, bring new colour up under and in front of the old colour. When changing yarns, be very loose, do not pull tight – otherwise the edge on that side will be tighter and shorter than the other.

The pattern is inspired by the [Prism Wrap](#) by [StixAndCones](#).

techniques

LLI Lifted Increase: Left Slant

Insert right needle into the front of the stitch (*the purl bump*) below the next stitch on your left needle. Knit this stitch.

RLI Lifted Increase: Right Slant

Insert left needle into front of the stitch (*the purl bump*) below the last stitch you just knitted (*on the right needle*). Knit this stitch.

directions

set-up

With MC, cast on 3 sts. Knit for 6 rows in garter stitch (knitting every row). Pick up 3 sts along side edge, pick up 3 sts from cast on edge. (9 sts) Knit 1 row.

R1: With CC, SI 1st pwise, k2, RLI, k1, RLI, PM, k1, PM, LLI, k1, LLI, k3.

R2: SI 1 st pwise, knit to end of row, slipping markers as you come to them.

shawl

R1: With MC, SI 1st pwise, k2, RLI, k to next marker, RLI, sl m, k1, sl m, LLI, k to 3 sts bef next marker, LLI, k3.

R2: SI 1 st pwise, k to end.

R3: With CC, SI 1st pwise, k2, RLI, k to next marker, RLI, sl m, k1, sl m, LLI, k to 3 sts bef next marker, LLI, k3.

R4: SI 1 st pwise, k to end.

Work Rows 1 to 4 a total of 27 times. (*you should have 28 CC rows*)

Next Row: With MC, SI 1 st pwise, k to end of row.

Cast off loosely. Weave in ends.
