



Iro mittsBy Haley Waxberg

I'm on a mitten binge. once the temp drops another nitch i'll probably go on a hat binge. for now, mitts for all! i'm diggin' this colour combo too, i call them my "Rainbow Goth" mitts. Hee-Hee!

Caveat

- 1. This pattern seems to work best with the yarn it was designed in, Noro Iro. The mitts are knit on small needles to make sure they are tight and keep out the wind.
- 2. To make sure your M1L & M1R increase stitches don't leave a little hole give it an extra twist.
- 3. I'll get around to adding more sizes one day, but for now if you have bigger hand consider adding more stitches to the pattern.

Siza

Women's M (4" wide across hand, 5" wide across palm with thumb gusset)

Materials

- 5mm/7.5" double pointed needles or 5mm/80cm Addi Turbo circular needles (2 DPN are needed for optional I-cord loop)
- 1 Skein Noro Iro 100g/120m, Colour 43
- 2 stitch markers
- small stitch holder or scrap yarn or large safety pin
- Darning needle
- Sewing needle & thread (optional for i-cord loop)

Gauge

15 sts & 23 rows = 4"/10cm

Abbreviations

K......knit

K2tog.....knit 2 stitches together

M1......Increase: from the front, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into back ofloop.(also called M1L)

M1L.....Increase slanting to the left: from the front, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into back of loop (give the stitch an extra twist to prevent little holes)

M1R.....Increase slanting to the right: from the back, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into front of loop (give the stitch an extra twist to prevent little holes)

P......Purl

R.....Round or row

Techniques

Backward loop cast on

Rep Repeat

I-cord

Magic Loop for knittiing on circular needles

St st Stocking Stitch (Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row)

Pick Up Stitches

Instructions

• Cast on 28 sts on 3 double pointed needles (or 16 & 16 sts on circular needles for <u>Magic Loop</u> method) & join in round making sure not to twist sts.

Cuff

- Work in K1, P1 rib for 3"
- *K9, <u>M1</u>; rep from * to end of round. (31 sts)
- K 3 rounds.

Thumb Gusset

R1: K15, place marker, M1R, k1, M1L, place marker, knit to end. (3 gusset sts between markers)

R2: Knit

```
R3: k to marker, slip marker, M1R, k to nextmarker, M1L, slip marker, k to end (5 gusset sts between markers)
R4: Knit
R5: same as R3. (7 gusset sts between markers)
R6:knit
R7: same as R3. (9 gusset sts between markers)
R8:knit
R9: same as R3. (11 gusset sts between markers)
R10:knit
R11: same as R3. (13 gusset sts between markers)
R12:knit
R13: k to marker, remove marker, place gusset sts on stitch holder, cast on 1 sts
```

Top of Hand

- •K until work measures to top of little finger of 1.5" less than desired total length.
- *K8, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (28 sts)

with the **backwards loop** method, k to end of round. (31sts)

- *K5, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (24sts)
- •K 1 round.
- *K4, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (20sts)
- •K 1 round.
- *K3, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (16sts)
- •K 1 round.
- *K2, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (12sts)
- *K1, k2 tog; repeat from * to end. (8sts)
- *K2tog; repeat from * to end. (4sts)
- Cut yarn, thread tail through remaining sts, pull tight & fasten off.

Thumb

- Pick up gusset sts on holder on 3 dpn
- •Working in round k12, pick up & knit 4 sts. (17sts)
- •K13, k2tog, k2tog. (15sts)
- •K11, k2tog, k2tog, (13sts)
- •Work in round until thumb measures to end of tumb (1.5" from pick-up round)

Top of Tumb

- *K2 tog, k2; repeat from * to end. (9 sts)
- *K2 tog; repeat from * to end. (5 sts)
- •Cut yarn, thread tail through remaining sts, pull tight & fasten off. Weave in ends

I-cord Loops (optional)

- With 5mm DPN pick up & knit 2 sts.
- Slip the sts back to the other end of the needle and k the row again. work until cord measures 3". Cast off.
- On 1 mitten, sex wth corn down to the base to make a loop. On the other mitten with a regular sewing needle & sewing thread sew a snap on top of cord.
- Weave in ends

Finishing

- Weave in ends.
- Wash in Eucalan.
