



Travelling Ribs Cowl

Pattern by Liane Schwarz for Knit-O-Matic

This cowl is a fast and simple way to get acquantied with cables. It is made with super bulky yarn for maximum satisfaction and minimal effort. It makes a quick & easy gift, or keep it for yourself and bask in your friends' envy.

Size

A. Standard: 11" long and 15" wide (or 30" in c ircumference)

B. Longer: 18" long and 15" wide (or 30" in circumference)

C. Looser: 11" long, but will vary in accordance with the number of sts you choose.

D. Very Loose: unfathomable

Materials

- 1(1, 1, 2) skeins Cascade Magnum or Brown Sheep Burly Spun (120m of super bulky yarn) R 30-34: Follow instructions for R 4-8.
- 12mm-24" circular needles
- 1 large cable needle
- 1 stitch marker

Gauge

Approx 1.5 to 2 sts = 1 inch

Abbreviations

Cable 4 forward: slip next 2sts on cable hook or needle and hold them in front, knit the next two sts, then knit the sts held on cable hook.

K Knit Ρ Purl

R Round or row

St/s Stitch/es

T3F Twist 3 forward: slip 2 knit sts on to cable hook and hold them in front, purl the next st, then knit the 2 sts held on cable hook.

T3B Twist 3 back: slip 1 purl st on to cable hook and hold it in back, knit 2 sts, then purl st held on cable hook.

Directions

Cast on 60(60, 72, 84) sts and place a stitch marker to designate the beginning of your round.

R 1-3: *p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 4: *p2, T3F, T3B, p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 5: *p3, k4, p3, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 6: *p3, C4F, p3, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 7: *p3, k4, p3, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 8: *p2, T3B, T3F, p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 9-16: *p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

R 17: *p2, k2, p2, T3F, T3B; rep from * to marker.

R 18: *p2, k2, p3, k4, p1; rep from * to marker.

R 19: *p2, k2, p3, C4F, p1; rep from * to marker.

R 20: *p2, k2, p3, k4, p1; rep from * to marker.

R 21: *p2, k2, p2, T3B, T3F; rep from * to marker.

R 22-24: *p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

Versions A & C

Cast off all stitches in pattern. Leave a 6" tail to join your round and conceal your ends.

Versions B & D

R 25-29: *p2, k2; rep from * to marker.

MOVE YOUR STITCH MARKER 4 sts to the right.

R 35-37: Follow instructions for R 9-11.

Cast off all stitches in pattern. Leave a 6" tail to join your round and conceal your ends.

Finishing

Blocking for all versions should be light, since there is already plenty of drape in bulky yarn. Place a damp cloth over the cowl and press with a low iron. Be careful not to flatten any of your lovely cables.

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
