

Wayfinder Quilt

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Level: Confident beginner and above

Finished Size: 62" x 62"

Description: Make your own ultramodern Wayfinder throw quilt top in one of a variety of styles and color variations. The Wayfinder design represents the idea that, in a broad sense, we never really “arrive”; we are always navigating and re-orienting ourselves toward new directions. With this in mind, the design seeks to remind us to live in and appreciate each point on this long, winding path - not just the destination. Brooke will walk you through the construction of this unique, modern quilt design, including tips for strip piecing, half rectangle triangles, and putting your own personal spin on your quilt.

Please cut all pieces before class.

Supply list:

Wayfinder quilt pattern (with templates printed) PATTERN is a DOWNLOADABLE purchase at stitchinpost.com (Note: pattern needs to be purchased before class and brought to class)

Basic quilting supplies which include: machine, thread, needle, 6" x 24" acrylic ruler, cutting mat, rotary cutter, pins, soluble pen, washi tape)

Fabric, if making Five-Color variation:

- Color 1 (background): 3¼ yds
- Color 2 (triangles): 7⁄8 yd
- Color 3 (squares): ½ yd
- Color 4 (inner rectangle): 3⁄8 yd
- Color 5 (outer rectangle): 7⁄8 yd

Fabric, if making Scrappy variation:

- Color 1 (background): 3¼ yds
- 9 total Fat Quarters or ¼ yd cuts
