

Intermediate Machine Quilting

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You have taken a beginning quilt class and practiced and are not sure about how to do the next step.....this class is intended to stretch your skill levels and increase your confidence in those skills. We are going to make a whole cloth practice quilt and of course it will need to be finished after you get home, but you will have a plan and the skills to achieve your goal. I will provide line drawings to choose from and we will mark our fabric prior to sewing. Skills I hope to help with include following a line, echoing that line, ruler work (or not), and changing the fill stitches to create a beautiful background for the design you select.

Please have basic skills and knowledge of your machine - it is important to bring the instruction manual for the machine in case it is needed.

Supply List:

Two fat quarter size pieces (18" x 22") of fabric - one for the top (solid) and one for the back.

One fat quarter size (18" x 22") piece of batting

Safety pins for layering

Topstitch needles - size 90

Threads that contrast with the fabric you chose. We are going to see your stitches!
Bring more than one spool of thread and more than one weight of thread.

Ruler foot for your machine if you have one - if you are unsure, you can decide in class if you wish to buy one from your sewing machine dealer after you have tried using it - I will let students use my machine for that purpose.
