We will learn how to prep our pieces and then we will learn a variety of embroidery stitches. This is a great class for beginners or advanced students -- anyone who likes to hand stitch.

Lab fee covers a linen fat quarter, a journal and several wool pennies to get you started. You get to choose any pattern I am providing you want to go with your kit. I usually bring some extra wool pennies with me as well in case you will want to trade them out.

You won't need sewing machines – you can do that part at home after working on the hand stitches in class.

Lab fee of \$25 paid to instructor on class day (bring \$25 cash or check)

Supply List:

A variety of embroidery threads. DMC floss is great. Bring about 10 colors. If you have a collection of other threads bring some perle cottons or anything you have on hand as well.

You will need a variety pack of embroidery needles and a Milliners size 1 needle. Milliners needles are used for our wrapped stitches.

Basic sewing supplies.

A pin cushion.

A blue water soluble marking pen – Mark-B-Gone

Also a scrap piece of cotton batting 12" x 12" inches long.

Optional: An embroidery hoop if you prefer to use one.
