

Pile Of Pincushions

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Everyone loves pincushions! This is a fun, fast paced class. You will making five cute quick pincushions in 6 hours (time allowing)! We will be working with wool, cotton, suede, bamboo felt, woven ribbon, floss, fusible web, butcher paper, hot glue, super glue and a variety of stuffing. This class is for a confident beginner – and beyond.

Students will receive patterns in class.

Pre-cut kits for each pincushion available for purchase in class – (bring cash or check to instructor day of class)

Supply List for all pincushions:

- *Sewing Machine in good working order, that has a Buttonhole/Blanket stitch. Make sure you have the correct foot for this stitch.
- *Small glue gun and glue. I will have a couple of extras.
- *Basic sewing supplies
- *Good pair of fabric scissors
- *Good pair of paper scissors that can cut through wool and paper
- *Rotary cutter and mat, only if you haven't precut your fabrics before class.
- *Stuffing of your choice. I use Crushed Walnut Shells. Other stuffing to consider, PolyFil, Lavender, Rice, Plastic Filler Beads, or anything else you come up with.
- *Needles for stitching openings closed
- *1/2 yard freezer paper

For all students who have all their supplies and precutting ready at the start of class. I will have a free 6th pincushion kit to give you. But ALL the supplies and precutting must be done before class to receive the 6th kit.

Posy Pincushion Supplies

- 2 – 6” x 6” squares of wool for foundation & back
- 1 – 3” x 12” piece of wool for flower petals
- 1 – 2 1/2” x 2 1/2” square for flower center
- Thread to match wool pieces

Pretty Pin Keeper Supplies

2 – 7” x 7” squares for top & bottom of pincushion. The bottom could be a cotton fabric if you choose.

1 – 3 ½” x 12” piece of wool for flower petals

1 – 2” x 2” square of wool for flower center

4’ x 14” piece of fusible webbing

Thread to match wool

Spool Pincushion Supplies

1 – 3” wood spool

1 – 3mm wool ball

1 – 3 ½” x 3 ½” piece of wool for flower base

1 – 3” x 3” piece of wool for middle of flower

1 – 2 ½” x 2 ½” piece of wool for top of flower

1 – 1 ½” x 3” piece of green wool for leaf

1 – Skein of matching embroidery floss to wrap around wood spool

Optional – beads to sew around the base of wool ball. If you choose to use beads.

You will need 9 of four different colors that coordinate with the wool colors you’ve chosen.

Sunflower Pincushion Supplies

1 - 4 ½” x WOF (Width of Fabric) green fabric for leaf petals- **before class**

precut 7 – 4 ½” x 4 ½” squares

1 - 4 ½” x WOF yellow fabric for petals – **before class**

precut 7 – 4 ½” x 4 ½” squares

1 - 4 ½” x WOF second yellow fabric for flower petals - **before class**

precut 7 – 4 ½” x 4 ½” squares

1 - 7” x 7” square for Sunflower center

1 - 6” x 6” square of green for foundation

1 - 4” x 4” piece of cardboard for foundation

1 very heavy washer for pincushion bottom

Optional – bug button

Kit available through teacher: \$18.00 (kit will be precut)

Chicken Pincushion Supplies

13 different fabric scraps, 1” x 9” of each

2” x 2” square of gold suede for Chicken beak

2” x 2” square of red suede for Chicken comb

4" x 4" square of brown suede for Chicken tail
2 – small black beads or buttons for Chicken eyes

Stuffing

Chicken precutting before class

You will be making 2 Log Cabin blocks for the chicken body.

Cut 2 each of the following:

Center – 1" x 1"	Log #1 – 1" x 1"	Log #2 – 1" x 1 ½"
Log #3 – 1" x 1 ½"	Log #4 – 1" x 2"	Log #5 – 1" x 2"
Log #6 – 1" x 2 ½"	Log #7 – 1" x 2 ½"	Log #8 – 1" x 3"
Log #9 – 1" x 3"	Log #10 – 1" x 3 ½"	Log #11 – 1" x 3 ½"
Log #12 – 1" x 4"
