In this four day workshop you will start with a basic idea and learn to design your own pattern and using different techniques, accomplish the pictorial wall quilt. You will be using fusible web as a base but will be combining painting with inks and detailing with pens and more. We will analyze the work as you go, learning artistic design factors.

Be ready to purchase products; i.e. inks, pens, fusible web and fabric necessities during class at the school store.

## **Supply List:**

\* Photo or photos from which to work.

Enlargement of photo. Enlarge photo to the finished size. You can have this done at a Kinko's, Office Max, Fed X, or an architectural firm. Please use the thin cheapest paper.

If this is not possible, I will have an overhead projector in class for enlarging. Thus you will bring thin paper (such as newsprint)

the size of your finished project.

- \* Pencil and Eraser
- \* Freezer paper
- \* Wide blue masking tape (not carried by Stitchin' Post store)
- \* Scissors, both paper and GOOD small sharp pointed scissors
- \* Tsukineko Inks (if you already have them) Otherwise you will be able to purchase from the school store
- \* Fantastix applicators (brush tip) with caps for each color. Again available at school store.
- \* 1/4 yard high grade muslin for a scrub sheet
- \* Fine line and ultra-fine line sharpie pens
- \* Clear vinyl, medium gauge, the size of your enlargement. (not carried by Stitchin' Post store)

You can find this in the vinyl tablecloth area at Joanne's or Hobby Lobby.

- \* Light Fusible web. I prefer Pellon 805 Wonder Under. Start with about 3 yards.
- \* Teflon pressing sheet
- \* Colored pencils
- \* Background (or base) fabric the size of your project plus a couple of inches each way.

A variety of fabrics representing your photo. 1/4 yard or larger depending on the size of your project. I prefer batiks. Keep in mind texture, scale, and value as well as your colors.

- \* Tweezers
- \* Light box (optional) (not carried by Stitchin' Post store)
