Class Overview:

This is a fun way to finish Quilter's Affair — making a Just For Fun Mystery Quilt.

This quick and easy to make quilt features a layer cake plus one more fabric that works well with the fabrics in the layer cake. Plan on a scrappy finish with your layer cake as it makes an approximate 58" x 58" quilt. And there are no templates, appliqué, triangles, circles or y-seams in this quilt.

Confident Beginner and Beyond

Pattern will be provided in class.

Supply List:

1 Layer Cake containing 42 - 10" x 10" squares

1 yard of a fabric that goes well with the fabrics in the layer cake.

(It could be one of the fabrics in the layer cake, so if there is one you would like to have a bit more of it in the quilt top.) Fabric amount also includes enough for binding.

Backing needed: 4 yards (not needed in class)

Basic sewing supplies include your sewing supplies, cutter, rulers and cutting mat plus your machine, it's cord and it's foot pedal.

Pre-class cutting instructions:

From each layer cake 10" square cut 1 (and only 1) 2" x 10" strip.

Put these in a little baggie and bring to class.

Bring all the remaining 8" x 10" layer cake pieces.
