In this class, let us take a new look at strip piecing by folding in improvisation techniques and manipulating the fabrics to add soft curves or waves into our designs. You will design your own quilt layout using soft curves and start constructing your strip-pieced quilt, on the fly, with the aid of a design wall.

Skill Level - Beginner to Intermediate No pattern purchase required.

Supply list:

Students will be expected to bring their own sewing machines with a 1/4" foot. Also, the following supplies:

- Large Bag of 1 1/2 inch strips of a variety of colors + neutrals (a mix of prints and solids is recommended)
- Rotary cutter
- Small cutting board
- Thread (50 wt) for piecing
- Fabric marker
- Ruler (at least 12 inches)
- Standard sewing kit items (seam ripper, fabric scissors, pins, etc.)

Optional supplies:

- Freezer Paper
- Paper Scissors
