This class introduces the concept of curved piecing with templates* to create a broken trellis quilt using a pattern. The fabrics you use will give a different feel to the quilt so you can use this pattern to play with patterns or solids fabrics or bold or more muted palettes.

*Temporary Templates using Freezer paper will be created in class, but I highly recommend the Make It Curvy 12 piece Template Set with Bag carried on The Stitchin' Post website (stitchin@stitchinpost.com)

Skill Level - Beginner to Intermediate No pattern purchase required.

Supply list:

Students will be expected to bring their own sewing machines with a 1/4" foot. Also the following supplies:

- Fabric
 - o For a two color design bring two yards of 2 different fabrics.
 - o For a scrappy look, a mix of Fat quarters (solids or prints in a warm or cool color way), and 1 yard of a complementary color or neutral color fabric.
- Rotary cutter
- Small cutting board
- Thread (50 wt) for piecing
- Fabric marker
- Glue stick
- Square ruler to cut a 6 ½ inch block and a 12 ½ inch block
- Standard sewing kit items (seam ripper, fabric scissors, pins, etc.)
