Let's begin your journey with learning 3 to 4 basic embroidery stitches so you can start working on your personal traveling scroll. A great project to take with you when you are traveling afar or to your own backyard garden. We will attach memorable pieces of your own cloth (as well as the ones we provide), paper and embellishments with the embroidery stitches you will be learning in class or are already familiar with. Beginners welcome.

The substrate cloth provided to the students in the kit will be approx. 6" by 60" linen. Since it is a natural product, it may slightly vary in color and weave.

Kit includes: \$15.00 payable to teacher on class day – either cash or check Scroll travel pouch, base cloth, pieces of specialty fabrics and embellishments. Specialty threads are available to use in the classroom along with needles.

Supply List: Please bring with you.

Small scissors/snips

Fabric glue stick

Specialty threads if you have your own favorites or use ours. They will be provided to use during class time.

Craft/fabric scissors

Additional small pieces of cloth (sheers and hand dyed work well, as do small embellishments)

A small embroidery hoop and open weave cloth for practice stitches would be helpful if you are a beginner, but not necessary.

Bring a garment or accessory to apply your patch if you like.
