You will be making a layered embroidered patch to embellish top, jeans, bag/tote or hat. Beginners welcome.

Use your own or teacher's design (created with a wash away base which will be provided for you). You will have a variety of designs to choose from. Learn 3 to 4 basic embroidery stitches that will enable you to create a patch to embellish an item of clothing or an accessory you bring with you.

Using kantha squares provided in the kit, over-dyed wool and assorted other fabrics will help create an interesting piece with faster results. Attach the patch with fusible webbing (provided) or incorporate more hand stitching onto your piece for added interest. You can choose additional fabrics to layer your patch to achieve an interesting look in less time.

Kit includes: \$15.00 payable to teacher on class day – either cash or check

Base fabric (denim/heavy weight linen), design on wash away stabilizer (blank stabilizer will also be provided if you wish to draw your own). Kantha, over dyed wool and additional fabrics for leaves and flower. Threads to use during class time and embroidery needle. Assorted fabrics to layer patch will also be available to students.

Supply List: please bring with you. Fabric glue stick Craft/fabric scissors Specialty threads (if you have favorites or use ours).

Bring a garment or accessory to apply your patch if you like.
