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## Sarah Fielke Big Woods Block Material Requirements

Hi everyone! I can't wait to see you back at my favourite quilting event in July.

**PLEASE READ THE BELOW CAREFULLY AS THERE ARE SEVERAL OPTIONS FOR PATTERN AND FABRIC REQUIREMENTS. Supply list is on second page.**

In this class we will be making one square from my Big Woods quilt, which is the 2024/25 Free Spirit Block of the Month, with Tula Pink fabrics. The pattern for the entire quilt is a separate purchase from this class, and the BOM does not begin until August 1. If you are going to subscribe, or have subscribed, to the BOM program, you do NOT need to pay the pattern fee for this class, however you will need to email me [sarah@sarahfielke.com](mailto:sarah@sarahfielke.com) and let me know that you are a subscriber, as well as the email address you have used to subscribe. If you intend to subscribe but haven't yet, please do so and then email me at least a few days before class, or the class pattern fee will still be payable.

There is a kit available for the full quilt with the exact fabrics as I used to make my quilt, which has been put together by Free Spirit especially for the Big Woods BOM. The Stitchin' Post has a very limited amount of these kits available, so if you would like one please snap it up asap!! The pattern subscription fee is available at [www.sarahfielke.com](http://www.sarahfielke.com) and is a separate purchase to the fabric kit. It includes the full 12 month pattern and printable templates, as well as access to the teaching videos that feature Sarah and Tula making the quilt together.

If you are NOT a subscriber to the BOM and just want to make the one panel in class -

**There is a pattern fee of \$15, please bring it to class in cash\***. The pattern contains the instructions and templates for the one block we will make in class only. This fee cannot be refunded if you decide to join the BOM and purchase the full pattern at a later date.

### **Optional:**

**There is a Big Woods template set for the roof of the house, and also a limited edition Big Woods triangle ruler for making the Bears Paw section of the blocks. These are both OPTIONAL, but available from my website. I can also supply the gel pen, liquid glue and milliners needles, 80 weight thread and a sandpaper board for tracing. If you would like to order any of these, please place the order at my website, [www.sarahfielke.com](http://www.sarahfielke.com), and then email me that it is for class at Sisters, and I will refund the postage for you and bring your items to class.**

The block/panel we are making in class will finish at either 20 1/2" or 24 1/2" square (we will discuss those options in class). If you are making the full quilt, the block will finish at 24 1/2" which is the size for the blocks in the quilt. If you aren't making the whole Big Woods quilt, this is a lovely center for a medallion quilt, a wall hanging or a cushion and we can discuss making it larger or smaller by adding/subtracting border pieces.

## **Material Requirements and Supply List:**

### **Things you will need on hand for class:**

\*Pattern fee of \$15

- Sewing machine
- Thread for piecing
- Rotary cutter, ruler and small mat
  
- Milliners needles #10 or #11
- 50 or 80 weight cotton thread to match or blend with your appliqué fabrics
  - Liquid appliqué glue and a silver gel pen for my method of needleturn appliqué
  
- Glue stick for paper
- Scissors for fabric and paper, and small sharp embroidery scissors

- **Fabric (if you ARE using the Big Woods kit fabric):**

Bring the kit as supplied from The Stitchin' Post, OR to minimize the amount of fabric you need to bring from home:

- o Cut:

- one 6 1/2" strip and one 2 1/2" strip from Tiny Dots - Cosmic (cream and pink background)
- one 2 1/2" strip from Hexy Rainbow - Ink (triangles)
- Sixteen 2 1/2" squares cut carefully from ANY PASTEL solids (pastels only)

- o Bring:

- Solids - Glitter (block background square)
- Solids - Mystic (house side)
- PomPom - Myrtle (green and blue spot for tree leaves)
- Mineral - Sapphire (blue mineral for tree trunk)
- Unconditional Love - Bluebell (house roof)
- Hexy - Sunshine (house windows and door)
- Tiny Dots - Watermelon (house front)
- Daisy Chain - Blossom (house roof front)

- **Fabric (if you are NOT using the Big Woods kit fabric):**

- o Fat quarter for contrast square at center of background (shown as purple in pic)
- o 11" strip of background (shown as cream in pic)
- o 3" strip of fabric with good contrast for triangle points
- o Sixteen 2 1/2" squares for Bears Paw corner squares
- o Fat 8th for tree top
- o Fat quarter for tree trunk
- o Fat 8ths for house roof, roof front, windows, side and house front
