- 32 Dresses -- a 10 " square or a fat quarter would work for each dress
(32 fat quarters total or a 10 " layer cake - which usually contains $40-10^{\prime \prime}$ squares)
- Backgrounds -- 8 to 10 fat quarters
- Heads, Hands and Feet -- scraps, you need a least $21 / 2 " \times 8$ " piece

Border - 2 yards
NO PRE-CUTTING required
