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Class Level – Intermediate Finished size of Sparkle is 60" x 60"

Supply List:

Sewing machine with ¼ inch foot or at least your ability to make Accurate ¼ inch seams
Rotary cutter, cutting mat, and 18" or longer straight ruler.
Thread
Other basic sewing supplies: seam ripper, pins, etc.
Pattern required: Sparkle Pattern available at the Stitchin' Post

Fabric list: (feel free to change your color scheme!)
From Yellow (block centers) Scraps – total of ¾ yard
From Assorted Lights (Background) Scraps – total of 2 1/3 yards
From Red (Secondary Background) Scraps – total of 2 1/3 yards
From Blue/Green (Star Points) Scraps – total of 3 yards

Recommended but not necessary: a 10 1/2" or larger square ruler and/or a 4 1/2" square ruler for trimming up patches and squares,

Pre-cutting options:

I like to create as we go, so I don't encourage a lot of pre-cutting, but I also know that pre-cutting does help in getting more done in class.
That being said, if you would like to, you can cut these precuts and drawn lines – then you can get a lot more done in class.

From assorted Yellows (block centers) cut:
36 - 4 ½" x 4 ½" Square A

From Assorted Lights (Background) cut:
72 - 4" x 4" squares – On the wrong side of each of these 72 – 4" squares draw a line in pencil from one corner to the other.
72 - 3 ½" x 4 ½" Rectangle C's

From assorted Reds (Secondary Background) cut:
72 - 4" x 4" squares
72 - 3 ½" x 4 ½" Rectangle B's

From Assorted Blues and Greens (Star Points) cut:
In Sets of 8 mostly matching sets - 36 sets of 8 - 2 ½" x 4 ½" Rectangle D's (288 in all)
