Perfect for all skill levels.

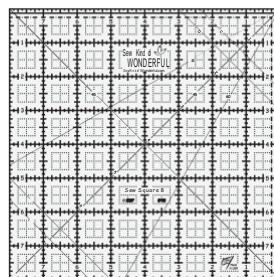
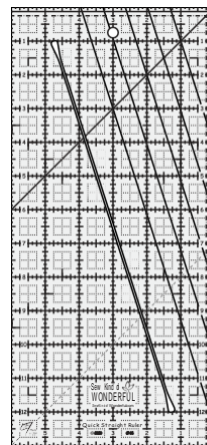
Uses the original Quick Straight Ruler™ by Sew Kind of Wonderful



Compass Quilt 59" x 59

Materials:

- (12) 1/4 yard cuts assorted focus fabrics
- 1/2 yard focus - yellow
- (2) 2/3 yard cuts assorted neutral backgrounds (light sage & white)
- (3) 3/4 yard cuts assorted neutral backgrounds (black, cream, & tan)
- 4 yards backing fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric
- Quick Straight Ruler™
- Sew Square 8™ (recommended) Compass Sewing Machine
- Basic sewing supplies including cutting mat And 45mm rotary cutter
- Quilt pattern provided in class.



*numbers correspond with numbered fabrics in pattern

Materials for 1 block:

Fabric 2

- (4) 4" x 61/2" focus fabric for compass points
- (1) 21/2" x 21/2"
- (4) 11/2" x 11/2"

Fabric 13

- (4) 4" x 4" for snowball corners
- (2) 11/2" x 21/2"
- (2) 11/2" x 41/2"

Fabrics 1, 4, 7, 12

- (1) 4" x 4" of each fabric

Background (BG3)

- (4) 4" x 61/2"
- (8) 11/2" x 2"
- (2) 8" x 8"

BG1 (1) 8" x 8"

BG5 (1) 8" x 8"

BG4 (1) 8" x 8"
