Just cut, sew, and square-up.

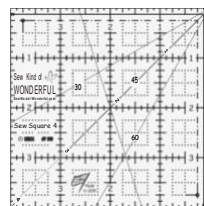
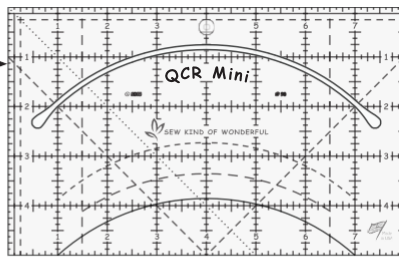
Perfect for all skill levels.

**Materials:**

- (10) 3/4 yard cuts assorted focus fabrics for curves
- (4) 1/2 yard cuts assorted fabrics for flying geese
- (4) 3/4 yard cuts assorted neutral background fabrics
- 5-1/2 yards backing
- 2/3 yard binding
- QCR Mini Ruler™
- Sew Square 4™
- Crisscross Applesauce pattern (provided in class)



**Class goal:**

Lots of sewing, sharing, laughter, chocolate, and 1-2 blocks.

**Bring to class:**

- Sewing machine (if not provided)
- general sewing supplies
- cutting mat
- 45mm rotary cutter
