Pattern Required Cascade Cones available at the Stitchin' Post

FABRIC:

Note: Look for high-quality felted wool.

Background: Cut 1 rectangle - 15 1/2" x 8 1/2" neutral color

Cones: 7 Small scraps (4"x 5" min.) or 1 fat quarter

Stem: 1/4" strip approximately 20" long

Borders: Cut 2 - 2" x 8 1/2" for sides and cut 2 - 2" x 18 1/2" for top and bottom (You may come to class with borders attached, or not. If you sew them before class, attach sides first and then top and bottom. Press seams open.)

NOTIONS:

!! No Sewing Machine Required For Class !! Paper & Fabric Scissors #2 pencil for tracing pattern Chalk marking pencil Thimble (optional)

Needles: #18 Chenille, #24 Chenille, Milliners #1, Milliners #3

Thread: Ellana Wool/Poly in colors to match shapes. This is for the actual appliqué.

Perle Cotton: Eleganza in an assortment of colors and weights (3, 5, and 8) for decorative/embroidery stitching.

We will discuss the perle cottons in class. You can make choices in the store at that time if need be.
