Online Registration opens for all workshops, lectures, events at 10:00 am PST, **Wednesday, January 8, 2025**, on *stitchinpost.com*

All registration is online only. No registrations will be taken via USPS mail, e-mail, paper (walk-in), phone, or fax. **Note that again this year, there will be no registration fee.**

Our registration system requires all students to create a Stitchin' Post customer account before completing checkout. You may create your account before registration to save time. If you already have an account, please make sure all of the information, especially your email address is correct. If your email address has changed, you will need to update it or create a new account.

Classes are viewable online from Dec. 18th - Jan. 5th.

All classes will appear as "sold out" until registration opens, but don't worry they aren't.

Classes are not available for viewing online after Jan 5th as we prepare for registration.

On registration day, be sure to read all of the instructions for registering posted on *stitchinpost.com*.

All classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. Putting a class in your shopping cart does not guarantee you a seat - the seat is not yours until your order has been charged and processed. Our system allows you to register for only a single seat in each workshop. (Excludes evening and Sunday programs.) If you wish to register for a friend, you will have to log in to their (or a separate) account to do so. Once a class fills, a wait list will be turned on. If a seat opens up, the first person on the wait list will be emailed. You will have **24 hours** to respond, after that, the next person on the wait list will be sent an email.

Tote bags and name tags for Quilter's Affair participants are available at the High School beginning Monday, July 7 from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. (Early pick-ups are available Saturday & Sunday, July 5 & 6, at the Stitchin' Post from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm.) Tote bags and name tags will be issued to all students who have **registered for a Workshop**, but not if you have only registered for Special Events.

All workshops, lectures and evening programs (BINGO, Main Event) are held at the Sisters High School. The Quilt Walk, Black Butte Ranch Quilt Show, Sisters Outdoor Quilt Show, and Quilt Show Sunday are all held at various locations around Sisters (specified with the information for each event).

Each workshop is coded by level of expertise: **Beginner** workshops are for people who have little or no experience with quilt making; **Confident Beginner** workshops require you to have rotary cutting and piecing experience; **Intermediate** workshops require you to be comfortable doing your own interpretation of patterns/designs; and **Advanced** workshops require you to be comfortable with all levels of designing and creating quilts.

We have workshops that run two different times: Most classes are 8:30 am to 3:30 pm with a lunch break at 11:30 am. Susie Zeitner's fused glass classes take place at her studio and run 9:00 am - 12:00 pm.

Some workshops require a specific book, pattern, or a Lab Fee for supplies. We have indicated these items in the class descriptions. Lab/Kit/Pattern Fees are to be paid (in cash) to the instructor at class time. Most one-day workshops are \$130, two-day workshops are \$260, and three-day workshops are \$390. Some special class prices vary, depending on duration and whether supplies are provided.
