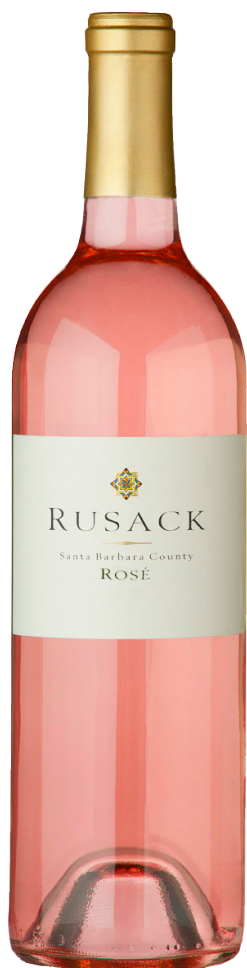

TASTING NOTES: CRISP AND REFRESHING, OUR ROSÉ BURSTS WITH AROMAS OF FRESH TANGERINE BLOSSOM AND NOTES OF GRAPEFRUIT, COMPLIMENTED BY DELICATE HINTS OF MINERALITY. BRIGHT ACIDITY AND A WONDERFULLY DRY FINISH MAKE THIS A PERFECT SUMMER WINE.

Our Rosé is created from select Pinot Noir grapes, which are harvested at peak maturity and earmarked for our Reserve program. Prior to fermentation, a small percentage of “blush” colored juice is set aside, while the resulting concentrated juice continues on the path to a Reserve release. This unique process leaves us with a delightfully intense Rosé wine perfect for those lighter moments in life.
