

SHOPPING LIST

Yarn (Worsted Weight)



Mary Maxim Starlette

[3.5 ounces, 180 yards

(100 grams, 164.6 meters) per ball]:

Red Wine (MC) 1 ball

White (CC) 1 ball

Knitting Needle:

14" Single Point

Size 8 (5.0 mm)

or size needed for gauge

EASY



SIZE INFORMATION

Finished: (unstretched)

10" [25.5 cm] long.

GAUGE INFORMATION

18 sts and 24 rows to 4" [10 cm]

without stretching measured over stockinette stitch using **suggested** needle or any size needle which will give the correct gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

k	knit
p	purl
inc	increase
dec	decrease
st(s)	stitch(es)
cm	centimeters
mm	millimeter
rem	remain or remaining
beg	beginning
rep	repeat
rnd	round
tog	together
St st	Stockinette Stitch
pssso	pass slipped stitch over k1
k1fb	Increase one st by knitting into front and back of next stitch

Note: Entire Stocking, not including Cuffs, is worked in St st - one row k (right side) and one row p (wrong side).

At end of every row, turn work and continue with next row of pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cuff:

Using CC1, cast on 60 sts.

Row 1-7: *K2, p2; rep from * to the end. (60 sts)

Row 8: *K2, p2; rep from * to the last stitch, k1fb. (61 sts)

Row 9: K to the end.

Row 10: P to the end.

Rows 11-40: Repeat Rows 9 & 10 twenty times.

Row 41: K2 tog, k to last 2 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso, turn. (59 sts)

Row 42: P to the end.

Rows 41-50: Repeat rows 9 & 10 four more times.

Row 51: K2 tog, k to last 2 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso. (57 sts)

Row 52: P to the end.

Rows 53-60: Repeat Rows 9 & 10, 4 more times.

Row 61: K2 tog, k to last 2 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso. (55 sts)

Row 62: P to the end.

Rows 63-70: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 four more times.

Row 71: K2 tog, k to last 2 sts, sl 1, k1, pssso. (53 sts)

Row 72: P to the end.

Rows 73-86: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 seven more times.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail long enough to sew back seam.

Divide for Heel and Instep:

With right side of work facing you, sl first 13 sts onto a st holder for the right half of heel, slip next 27 sts onto another stitch older for instep, slip last 13 sts onto another needle for left half of heel.

Left Half of heel: Using CC1 and with wrong side of work facing you, continue as follows:

Row 1: P to end of row. (13 sts)

Row 2: Sl 1, k 12.

Rows 3-18: Repeat Rows 1 & 2 eight more times.

To Turn Left Heel:

Row 19: P2, p2 tog, p1, turn. (12 sts)

Row 20: Sl 1, k3, turn.

Row 21: P3, p2 tog, p1, turn. (11 sts)

Row 22: Sl 1, k4, turn.

Row 23: P4, p2 tog, p 1, turn. (10 sts)

Row 24: Sl 1, k5, turn.

Row 25: P5, p2 tog, p1, turn. (9 sts)

Row 26: Sl 1, k6, turn.

Row 27: P6, p2 tog, p1. (8 sts)

Cut yarn leaving a long tail to seam. Place rem 8 sts on a st holder.

Right Half of Heel: Using CC1 and with right side of work facing you, continue as follows:

Row 1: K 13 sts from first st holder.

Row 2: Sl 1, p 12.

Rows 3-18: Repeat Rows 1 & 2 eight more times.

To Turn Right Heel:

Row 19: K2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, turn. (12 sts)

Row 20: Sl 1, p3, turn.

Row 21: K3, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, turn. (11 sts)

Row 22: Sl 1, p 4, turn.

Row 23: K4, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, turn. (10 sts)

Row 24: Sl 1, p5, turn.

Row 25: K5, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, turn. (9 sts)

Row 26: Sl 1, p6, turn.

Row 27: K6, sl 1, k1, pssso, k1. (8 sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a 3-4" tail.

Using same needle and MC, pick up and k9 sts along inner edge of right half of heel, k 27 sts from st holder, pick up and k9 sts along inner edge of left half of heel, k8 sts from left heel st holder. (61 sts)

Shaping the Gusset:

Row 1 and every alternate row following: (*wrong side*) P to end of row.

Row 2: K 14, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 14. (59 sts)

Row 4: K 13, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 13. (57 sts)

Row 6: K 12, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 12. (55 sts)

Row 8: K 11, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 11. (53 sts)

Row 10: K 10, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 10. (51 sts)

Row 12: K9, k2 tog, k 29, sl 1, k1, pssso, k9. (49 sts)

Row 13: P to end of row.

Foot:

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Repeat these 2 rows until work measures about 7" [17.5 cm] from color change.

Next Row: K 23, k2 tog, k 24. (48 sts)

Next Row: P to end.

Cut MC, leaving a long tail for sewing.

To Shape Toe:

Using CC1 and with right side facing, continue as follows:

Row 1: K9, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 18, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k9. (44 sts)

Row 2 and every alternate row following: P to end.

Row 3: K8, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 16, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1 pssso, k8. (40 sts)

Row 5: K7, k2 tog, k2 sl 1, k1, pssso, k 14, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k7. (36 sts)

Row 7: K6, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 12, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k6. (32 sts)

Row 9: K5, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k 10, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k5. (28 sts)

Row 11: K4, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k8, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k4. (24 sts)

Row 13: K3, k2 tog, sl 1, k1, pssso, k6, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k3. (20 sts)

Row 15: K2, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k4, k2 tog, k2, sl 1, k1, pssso, k2. (16 sts)

Seaming the Toe:

Wrong side facing you, place first 4 sts onto st holder, sl next 8 sts onto needle not in use, sl last 4 sts onto another st holder.

Now beg with 4th st on first st holder, sl 4 sts onto 2nd needle, then pick up yarn and k4 from 2nd st holder. There are now 8 sts on each of 2 needles, ready for grafting according to instructions (see next page).

Grafting or Kitchener Stitch:

To join two sections of knitting without a ridge or seam, divide the stitches onto two needles evenly with the wrong sides of work facing one another.

Thread a needle with a length of yarn.

1. Insert needle into first stitch on front needle as if to knit, slip off needle.

2. Insert needle into second stitch on front needle as if to purl, leave on needle.

3. Insert needle into first st on back needle as if to purl, slip off needle.

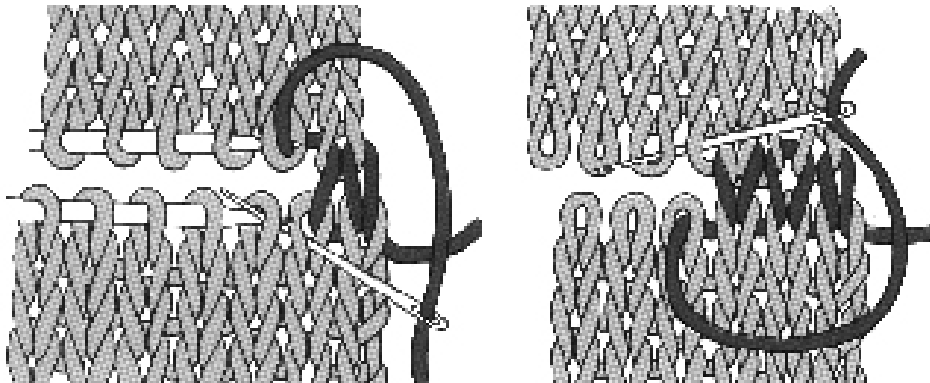
4. Insert needle into second stitch on back needle as if to knit, leave on needle.

Repeat these 4 steps until all sts have been worked. Fasten off.

To Complete:

Sew all seams with matching yarn. Embroider name if desired, just below Cuff.

Weave in all ends.
