## GAUGE INFORMATION

Center Cable = 3.5" [9 cm] wide Panel B = 2" [5 cm] wide and 17 sts and 22 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over reverse Stocking stitch, all using **suggested** needle or any size knitting needle which will give the correct gauge.



### STITCH GUIDE

k knit
p purl

cm centimeters

beg beg or beginning

dec decrease or decreasing

inc increase or increasing rem remain or remaining

rep rep or repeating

PM place marker
st(s) stitch(es)

rnd(s) round(s)

**C3L** Slip next st onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k2 from left needle, then k1 from cable needle.

C3R Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k1 from left needle, then k2 from cable needle.

**C4B** Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2 from left needle, then k2 from cable needle.

**T3B** Slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2 from left needle, then p1 from cable needle.

**T3F** Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front, p1, then k2 from cable needle.

**C2B** Slip next st onto cable needle and hold to back of work, k1 from left needle, then k1 from cable needle.

**T2BP** On wrong side row, slip next st onto cable needle and hold to back of work, p1 from left needle, then p1 from cable needle.

Panel B: (worked over 13 sts)

Row 1: (right side) C2B, p1, k7, p1, C2B.

Row 2: T2BP, k1, p7, k1, T2BP.

Row 3: C2B, p1, C3R, k1, C3L, p1, C2B.

Row 4: T2BP, k1, p7, k1, T2BP.

Repeat these 4 rows for Panel B.

Center Cable: (worked over 20 sts)

Row 1: (right side) P2, k2, p4, k4, p4, k2, p2.

Rows 2 and 4: K2, p2, k4, p4, k4, p2, k2.

Row 3: P2, k2, p4, C4B, p4, k2, p2.

Row 5: P2, [T3F, p2, T3B] twice, p2.

Row 6: K3, [p2, k2] 3 times, p2, k3. Row 7: P3, T3F, T3B, p2, T3F, T3B, p3.

Row 8: [K4, p4] twice, k4.

Row 9: P4, [C4B, p4] twice.

Rows 10, 12 and 14: [K4, p4] twice, k4.

Row 11: [P4, k4] twice, p4.

Row 13: P4, [C4B, p4] twice.

Row 15: P3, T3B, T3F, p2, T3B, T3F, p3.

Row 16: K3, [p2, k2] 3 times, p2, k3.

Row 17: P2, T3B, p2, T3F, T3B, p2, T3F, p2.

Row 18: As Row 2.

Row 19: P2, k2, p4, C4B, p4, k2, p2.

Row 20: K2, p2, k4, p4, k4, p2, k2.

Repeat these 20 rows for Center Cable.

## INSTRUCTIONS

#### Back:

\*\*Using longer circular needle, cast on 86(102) sts. Do not join in rnd, but work back and forth as follows:

**Row 1:** (right side) K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end. Repeat these 2 rows until band measures 2" [5 cm], ending after a Row 2.

Now work in pattern as follows: Row 1: (right side) P 20(28), PM, work Row 1 of Panel B over next 13 sts, PM, work Row 1 of Center Cable over next 20 sts, PM, work Row 1 of Panel B over next 13 sts, PM, p 20(28). Row 2: K 20(28), sl M,

work Row 2 of Panel B to next M, sl M, work Row 2 of Center Cable to next M, sl M, work Row 2 of Panel B to next M, sl M, k 20(28).

Patterns are now set in place.

Now continue to work correct row of cable pattern between M's and keep rem sts outside M's in reverse

St st (right side row p, wrong side row k), until piece measures about 26(29)" [66(73.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a Row 20 of Center Cable.

Cast off first 26(33) sts, work in pattern over next 33(35) sts, then place these center 34(36) sts on st holder for back neck, cast off rem sts.

#### Front:

Work same as given for Back until piece measures 23(25)"[58.5(63.5) cm] from cast on edge, ending after a wrong side row.

#### To Shape Front Neck:

Next Row: Work in pattern over first 30(38) sts, place next 26 sts onto st holder for front neck, join another skein of yarn to rem sts and work in pattern to end.

**Next Row:** Work in pattern to end on each side.

Now working both sides at the same time, keeping pattern correct, dec one st at each neck edge on next row, then every 6th row following until 26(33) sts rem for each side.

Now work even in pattern until each side measures same length as Back to cast off.

Cast off each side.

Sew both shoulder seams.

#### Collar:

Using shorter circular needle, with right side facing, k sts from back neck st holder, dec 4(6) sts evenly across, pick up and k 20(28) sts evenly down left side of front neck, k sts from front st holder, pick up and k 20(28) sts evenly up right side of front neck - 96(112) sts.

Join in rnd, placing a M after last st to indicate end of rnd. Slip M on each rnd.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 5" [13 cm]. Cast off loosely ribwise.

#### Left Side Band:

Using longer circular needle, with right side facing and starting at bottom edge of Front, pick up and k 139(159) sts evenly spaced to shoulder, then pick up and k 139(159) evenly spaced to bottom edge of Back - 278(318) sts.

Row 1: (wrong side) K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 3:** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 4: Buttonhole Row: P2, k2, p2, cast off next 2 sts, [(with one st rem on needle from cast off), rib next 17 sts, cast off next 2 sts] 3 times, rib to end.

Row 5: K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* across, casting on 2 sts over cast off sts of previous row.

Work 3 more rows in rib. Cast off ribwise.

#### Right Side Band:

Using longer circular needle, with right side facing and starting at bottom edge of Back, pick up and k 139(159) sts evenly spaced to shoulder, then pick up and k 139(159) evenly spaced to bottom edge of Front - 278(318) sts.

Row 1: (wrong side) K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 3: (wrong side) K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 4: Buttonhole Row: Rib to last 68 sts, cast off 2 sts, [(with one st rem on needle from cast off), rib next 17 sts, cast off next 2 sts] 3 times, rib to end.
Row 5: K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* across, casting on 2 sts over cast off sts of previous row.

Work 3 more rows in rib. Cast off.

#### To Complete:

With Poncho folded in half at shoulder seams, lay the Left Side Band and Right Side Band, side by side.

Sew a button to opposite Band, matching each buttonhole. Weave in all ends.
