## COMPONENTS OF **Marseille** AND **Metro**



### TEAK

Teak has always been a prized material for its elegance and durability due to the natural properties that other woods don't have such as the abundance of natural oils and rubber that is locked right into the grain of the timber. While all timbers contain oils that protect the tree, teak however, can retain these oils and rubber even after being felled and processed. Because of this, teak has greater naturally weather-resistant properties than just about any other type of wood. The oils also protect the wood from dry rot, which is a common problem in older wooden furniture. What's more, the oils and rubber protect the heart of the timber from invaders like fungi and parasites that can destroy other timber.

If left to colour naturally, the teak develops a silver-grey patina over time. This does not affect the performance or durability of the teak; it is merely a cosmetic change. If you wish to retain the colour of your teak, we recommend a teak sealer that can be obtained from specialist marine stores. Please note that the teak sealer can deepen the colour of the timber slightly.

#### Caring for Teak:

Caring for teak is a straightforward process, by giving it a brush down every few weeks that will work to remove any dust that has settled. Follow up with a wash with mild soapy water (dish washing detergent is fine) and then a hose down to remove any soapy residue.



### KWILA

Kwila has a hardness factor of 8.6 out of 10 as a result of its densely packed fibres making it one of the strongest and most durable outdoor timbers in the world. Added to this is the fact that it's naturally weather, pest and rot resistant. As with teak, kwila weathers to a silver grey patina if left unoiled. This does not affect the performance or durability of the kwila, it is merely a cosmetic change.

#### Caring for Kwila:

As Kwila is a very oily hardwood that can leach oil and tannins, we recommend placing your kwila furniture on a grassed area upon delivery and hosing it down thoroughly to remove these. If this step is not carried out and the furniture gets rained on, the oils and tannins will bleed out of the furniture, marking the ground below, be it concrete, tiles or decking. If you wish to retain the kwila colour of your furniture, we recommend the use of outdoor timber oil ever 6-12 months as a part of your furniture maintenance.

### 316 MARINE GRADE STAINLESS STEEL

There are three common grades of stainless steel 304, 308 and 316. The grade often used by outdoor furniture companies is 304, which is most likely to rust. Consumers should always select outdoor furniture that uses at least grade 316 stainless steel, as 316 contains an extra component called Molybdenum which is added to help resist corrosion to chlorides such as salt water. 316 will withstand the elements a lot longer, especially if the furniture is destined for use near the coast or beach. Marine Grade stainless steel (316) has a greater resistance to pitting, corrosion than other grades of steel. It is not usually used in residential outdoor furniture, however due to the harsh New Zealand climate FURNISH only uses the best materials available.

#### Caring for 316 Stainless Steel:

It is important to maintain your stainless steel furniture to keep it looking pristine. In most cases a wash down with warm soapy water (dish washing detergent is fine) will suffice, followed up by a rinse with clean water and a wipe down with a soft, clean cloth. Use polish pad to clean and wipe down in the direction of the polish on the steel. The closer the furniture is located to the beach, the more often maintenance will need to be carried out. If the furniture is beach/sea front, a monthly clean down is recommended to prevent pitting and marking.
