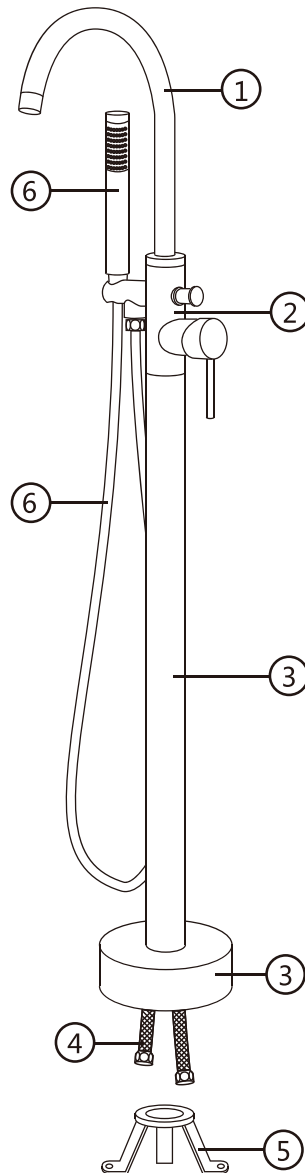

PARTS & DIAGRAM



1. Tub filler spout
2. Body
3. Floor (escutcheon)
4. Hot & Cold Flexible hoses x 2
5. Mounting bracket
6. Hand shower & hose
7. Expansion screw

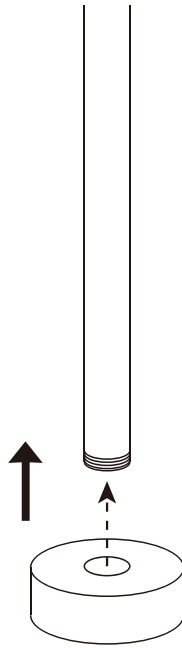
STEP 1

Lay the faucet down flat so that all parts can be easily viewed and accessed during assembly.

STEP 2

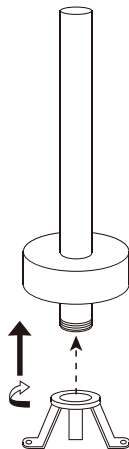
Slide the decorative escutcheon, or base, onto the body of the faucet. You may need to remove the mounting plate if already in place.

TIP: Make sure the rubber sealing gasket (if included) is around the rim of the escutcheon. Shift the escutcheon up the faucet so that you have enough room for your tools during installation.



STEP 3

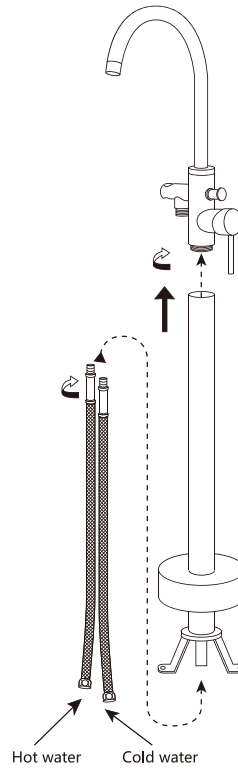
Attach the mounting bracket to the body of the faucet. If a hex nut was included with your faucet, screw the nut onto the body of the faucet followed by the mounting plate. The two should fit tightly together to create a seal.



STEP 4

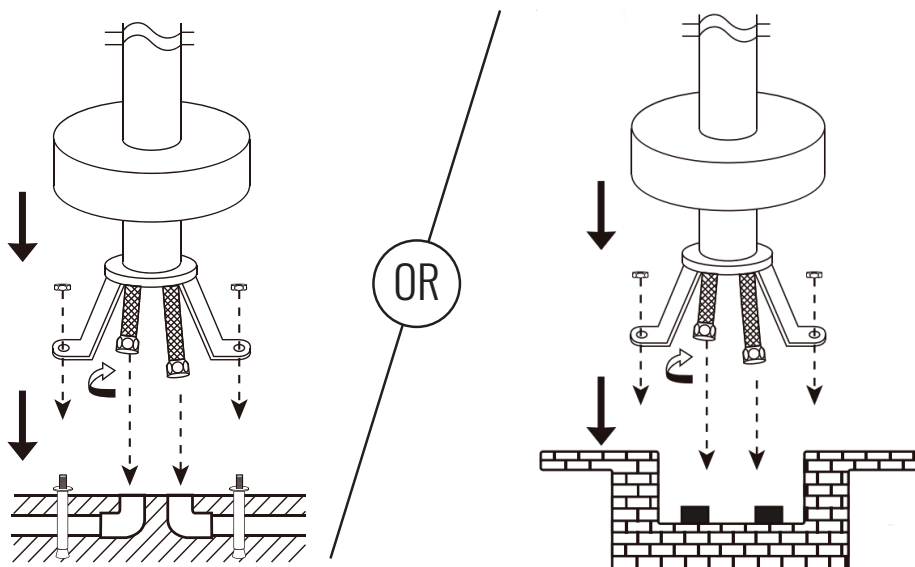
Connect the flexible hoses to the bottom of the faucet body. If the water feed tubes are already connected to your faucet, move on to step 5. These are meant to be hand tightened only. Once the hoses begin to warp as you turn them they have been tightened enough, any further tightening could damage the connection tubes.

TIP: Each hose is marked with a sticker, blue for cold and red for hot water. After the hoses have been connected place a piece of masking tape on the red, or hot water hose to help ensure that the two do not get crossed at any time during installation.



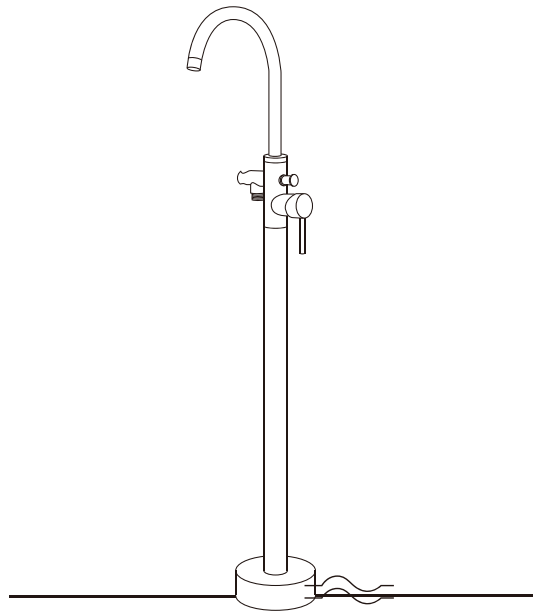
STEP 5

Thread the water feed tubes through the hole on the floor and connect to the main water supply via the under-floor access space. Briefly turn on the water supply to make sure there are no leaks in the water feed tubes before you fix the faucet to the floor. If no leaks are detected, turn off the water supply and continue with the installation. If leakage does occur, use your adjustable wrench to tighten the connections as necessary. If Problem persists, contact customer service at 213-425-3095.



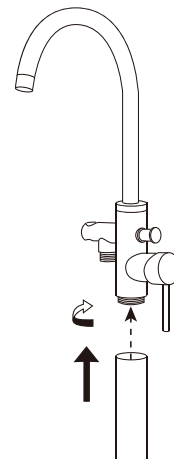
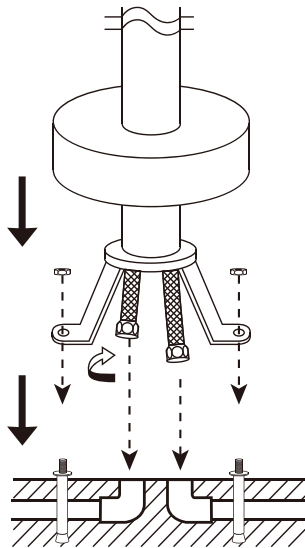
STEP 6

Sit the faucet upright with the mounting plate flat to the floor. Use your level to verify that the faucet is properly aligned. If the faucet is not level place a shim underneath the mounting plate and adjust as necessary.



STEP 7

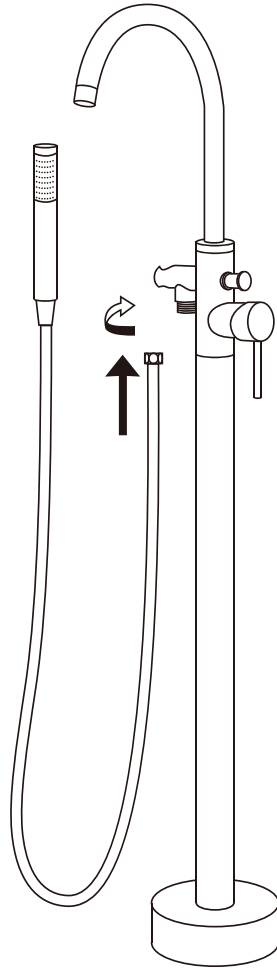
Secure the mounting plate to the floor using your drill and the appropriate mounting hardware. If there is a decorative escutcheon, slide it down over the mounting plate and press into place.



STEP 8

Finish your installation by attaching any hoses and/or handles that might be included. There is a bag of extra materials included in the packaging. There may be items that are not used at the time of installation but may be needed later. Do not discard these materials.

TIP: If your faucet features a hand shower attachment, screw the tapered end of the hose onto the hand shower so that the piece fits properly in the cradle.



STEP 9

Tighten the set screw located on the side of the faucet with your allen wrench to secure the spout in place.

STEP 10

When the faucet is installed turn on the water supply, check to make sure that all connections are tight (no water should be leaking) and that the hot and cold supplies are working correctly. If you have a hand shower, divert the water to the hose and allow the water to flow through the hose for approximately 5 minutes.

Implied warranties, including that of merchant ability or fitness for a particular purpose, are expressly limited in duration to the duration of this warranty. Eisen Home disclaims any liability for special, incidental or consequential damages.
