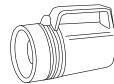

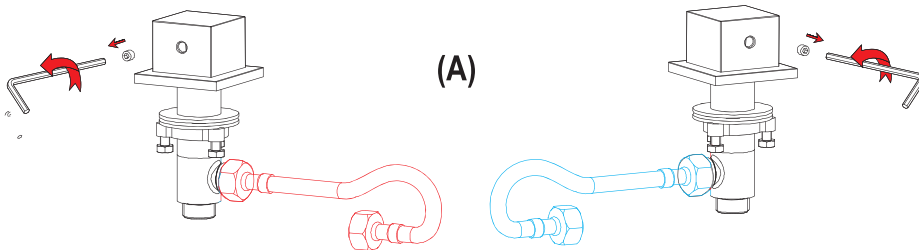

Hex key

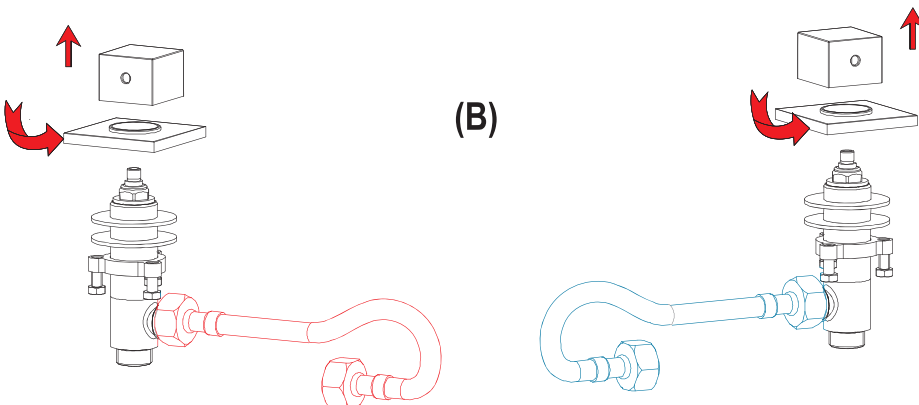
STEP 1

(A) Use the provided hex key to loosen the set screws



STEP 2

(B) Remove handles and unscrew spacers from the valve body

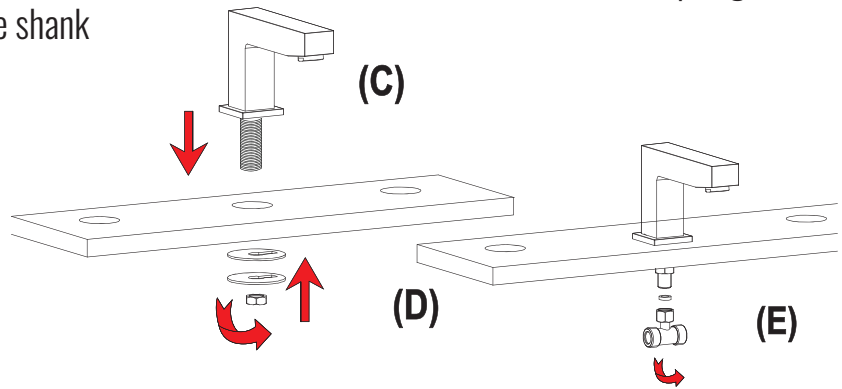


STEP 3

(C) Insert shank through the center hole in the sink

(D) Thread rubber washer, metal washer, and the nut onto the shank from below the countertop. Tighten the nut.

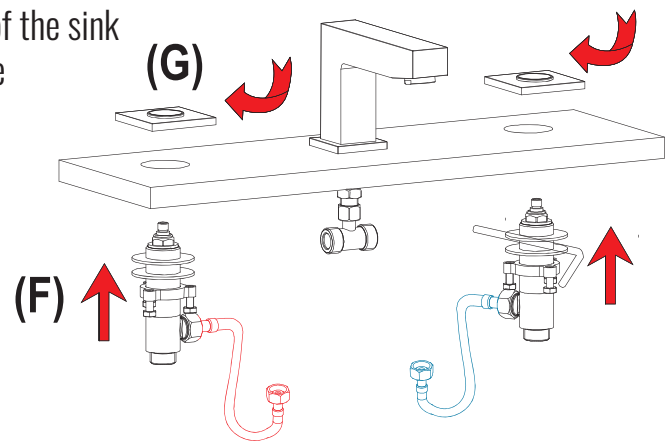
(E) Connect and tighten the T Joint to the shank



STEP 4

(F) Insert the handle valve body onto the outer hole of the sink

(G) Screw the spacer onto the valve body from above

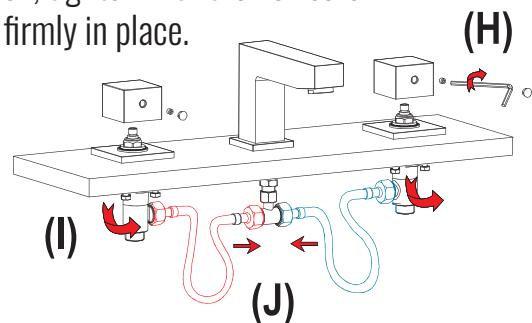


STEP 5

(H) Place the Handles onto the cartridge in a desired position, tighten with the hex screw.

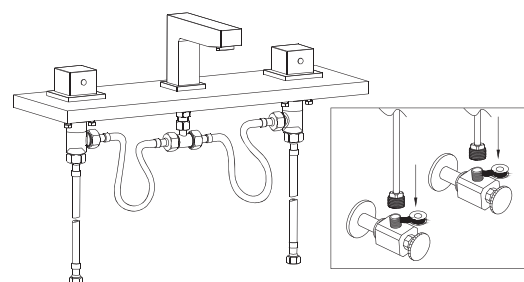
(I) From below the sink, tighten the nut on the shank until firmly in place.

(J) Connect the hoses from valve body to the T - joint.



STEP 6

Finally, make the connections to the water supply. Tighten everything and ensure there's no leakage.
