
## Ordinary Apron Pattern

## Prepare the template

Cut the template pages along the dashed lines. Match up the solid line on page A to the dashed line on page B, and tape the pages together along the matched up lines. Do the same on pages C and D. Then match the solid to dashed lines on piece AB with the dashed lines on piece CD and tape in place. You will have a piece that looks like the illustration. Cut the template out along the black line.

## Cut out the apron

From main fabric, cut a rectangle 31" by 35", if you are lining or hemming the apron. Cut a 31" by 35" rectangle from the lining fabric. If you plan to use bias tape for edging, cut the rectangle 30" by 34". Place the template on the top corners of the long side of the rectangle and cut along the curved edge, as illustrated on page D.

Cut the pocket pieces 15" wide by 10" high, one from main fabric and one from lining fabric.

Cut the neck pieces 2" x 21," one from main fabric and one from lining.

Cut the apron ties from main fabric, two pieces, each 1" x 38."

If you are using bias tape for the edges, instead of lining, you will need about 110" of 2" wide bias tape.
