



3 WAYS TO FEED RAW GOAT'S MILK

OPTION 1: STRAIGHT FROM THE BOTTLE

Pure Raw Goat's Milk on its own is the best choice for 99% of dogs and cats. Thaw the bottle and pour it over your pet's food. It's that easy.

OPTION 2: MAKE IT LACTOSE-FREE

For the most sensitive pets, you can make Raw Goat's Milk lactose-free with ease. Follow the chart below and add the appropriate number of drops of lactase enzymes dependent on the size of your bottle. Then shake it up and leave it in the refrigerator for 24 hours.

Milkaid:

Pint — 10 drops Quart — 20 drops
Half-Gallon — 40 drops

OPTION 3: FERMENT WITH ADDED PROBIOTICS

Fermentation is a very easy process. Follow the portion chart below, pour the probiotics, yogurt or kefir into your bottle of milk, shake it up and leave it on the counter for 24 hours.

Adored Beast:

Fido's Flora — 2 tsp per quart
Love Bugs — .25 tsp per quart
Gut Soothe — .5 tsp per quart
Healthy Gut — .5 tsp

Any other probiotic —

At least 2 billion CFU (in a serving) per quart.

Yogurt or kefir —

1 tbsp per quart.
