

# SNOWBALL FIGHT

## GAME RULES

**Number of Players:** 2 – 4

**Object of the Game:** To be the first player to win all 52 cards.

**Classic Rules (Based on the Game WAR)**

**How to Play:** Choose a dealer. The dealer shuffles and deals all the cards in the deck evenly between the players. Each player places his or her stack of cards face down, in front of him. Each player turns up a card at the same time and the player with the highest ranked card wins; and places the cards, face down, on the bottom of his stack. If the cards are the same rank, players must battle. Each player takes two more cards from his stack and turns one card face up and the other remains face down. The player with the highest-ranking card face up wins the battle and takes all the cards in play. If the turned-up cards are again the same rank, each player takes two more cards from their pile placing the first card face down and the other card face up. The player with the highest ranked card face up takes all the cards in battle, repeat until the battle is won.

**Scoring:** The Fight ends when one player has won all the cards.

**Variation 1 “Addition Snowball Fight”:** Two cards are played at once and added together. The highest sum wins the trick. Wars are played in the usual way, three cards face down, two cards up: the sum wins all 14 cards. Last player to have cards wins.

**Variation 2 “Subtraction Snowball Fight”:** Two cards are played at once, the lower subtracted from the higher. The highest sum wins the trick. Wars are played normally.
